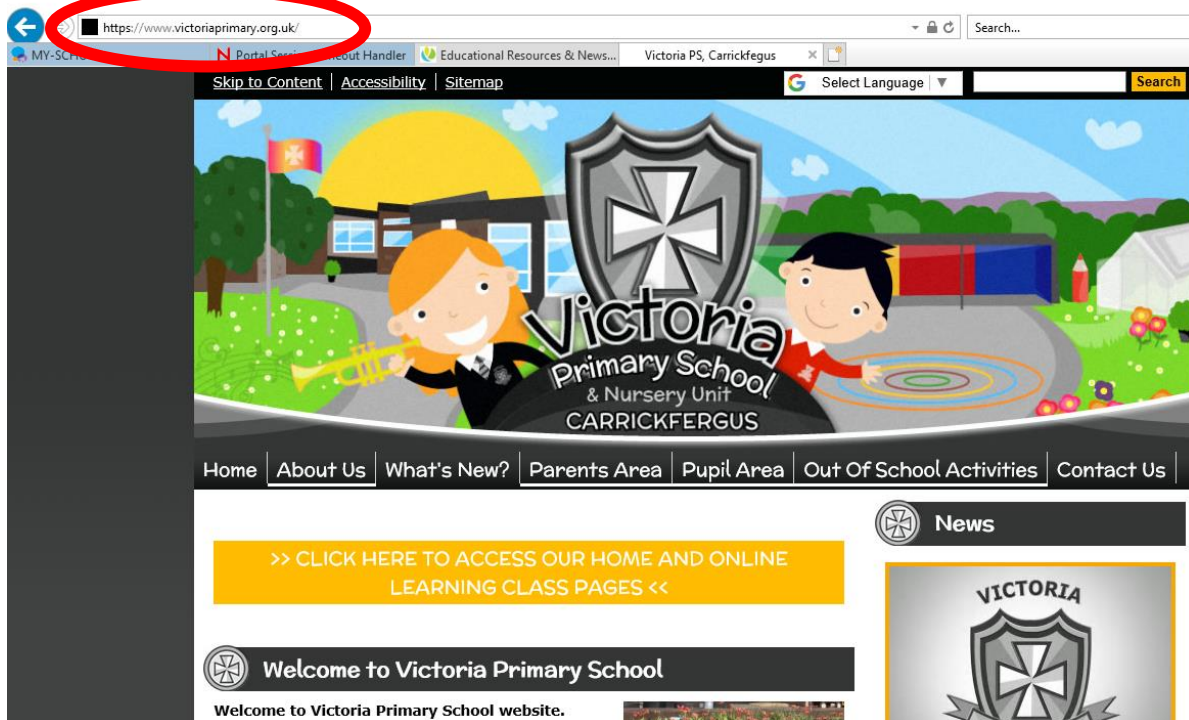
Dear Parents / Carers,

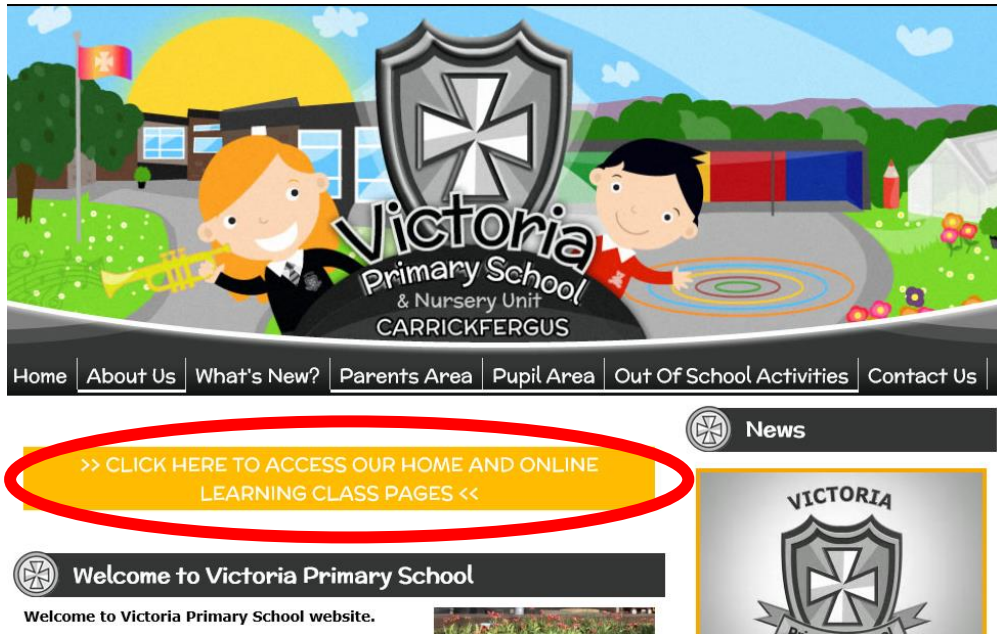

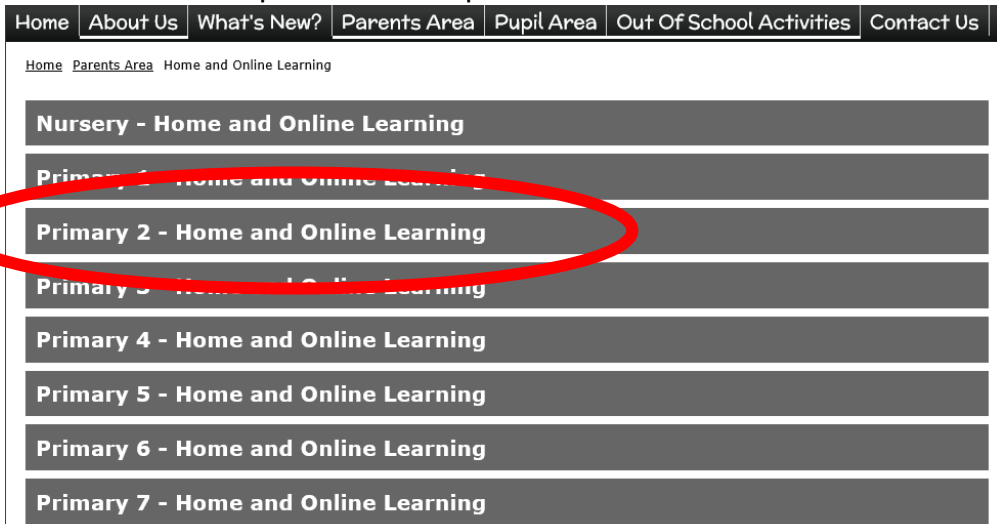

Literacy:

- Read every day and fill in reading record in pack.
- Continue learning Tricky Words (see planners).
- Continue working on phonics and blending using Sound Strips, double sound books, planners, phonics and blending powerpoints (see documents).
- Use the links in the Reading document on the website for online books and audio books – Oxford Owl is a super website.
- Play games outdoors as outlined in the Outdoor Learning in Literacy document and any games on the website.
- Phonics – Ruth Miskin Read Write in Phonics Sessions

For the majority of the work, you will not be required to print anything out. Work can be viewed on the screen and children can complete their work into their books that have been sent home with them. If an activity does require access to a printer and you do not have this, then don't worry.....you can give that activity a miss. It won't happen that often.

Please be advised that work for the following week will go live after 12pm on the previous Friday. For example, work for the week beginning Monday 11th May will be uploaded onto the school website after 12pm on Friday 8th May and so on.

This means that the previous instructions, videos and documents will be removed from the website. This is to ensure that each webpage does not get too cluttered with information. Like I have said all along.....**there is no right or wrong way to complete learning at home.** Do what you can. Anything is better than nothing. If you do come across any problems, then please do use SLIDO to communicate with me or class teachers. Hopefully, after the 1st week, we will have managed to iron out any technical issues.
