News At Holy Family

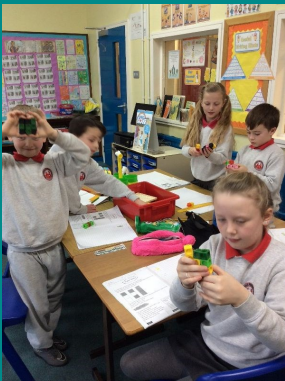
