# Homework Policy and Parent role

Thank you for your feedback last school year in relation to homework. We have taken onboard your feedback and made some changes. Homework will be given out on a Monday for the week to allow more flexibility. There will now be 3 written homeworks per week.

### Why is homework necessary?

Homework is planned for your child to help keep you involved in your child's learning and to reinforce skills taught in school. When homework is completed consistently and to a good level the children's attitude to learning and outcomes are greatly improved. We believe parents and school staff need to work in partnership to ensure that all children achieve their potential in school.

#### Parents should: -

Speak to your child's class teacher if your child is struggling with any aspect of school homework.

Sign the **Homework Monitoring Sheet** for P4-7 pupils each night. Inform the class teacher if there is any reason your child cannot complete their homework maybe due to illness, bereavement, or other family circumstances.

#### If homework is missing we will:

- 1. Send a reminder out via Seesaw App or the School Text Service.
- 2. The incomplete homework will be sent home to be completed.
- 3. Teachers will contact parents if there are ongoing issues with your child not completing homework.

Rewards will be given termly, such as an extra playtime or party, for all children who complete their homework.

Rewards will also be allocated to pupils who complete AR targets and achieve Mathletics goals.

Thank you all for your support as we all work together to provide the best education for all pupils. If anyone needs to discuss any aspect of school homework please contact the class teacher at any time or Mrs White will be happy to help.

#### WOODS PE UNIFORM
