Photography Policy 2019

Rationale

At our school, we promote the practice of taking photographs and video recording children to capture significant events, achievements, opportunities for learning and for promotional purposes.

The children may be photographed participating in school activities such as:

- Curriculum activities and first day in P.1
- Classroom or school activities
- Sports events
- School trips
- School open days and events
- Highlighting achievements
- Video recording in the classrooms for educational purposes
- Video recording a special event e.g. school Christmas concert.

These photographs may be used for display purposes in the school, for publication in the local press or for promotional purposes in the prospectus/school documents, newsletters, school website, etc.

Only children's Christian names will be attached to any photograph used outside the school e.g. local press and the school website. As a school, we feel it is important that pupil's achievements are recognised and pupils are proud and happy to feel valued. However, we are sensitive to those pupils who may not wish their photographs to be taken or used for any school purpose.

I request that you complete the attached form to indicate that you give your consent for your child's photograph to be taken or video recording made in accordance with this policy. The school cannot be held accountable for photographs or video footage taken by parents or members of the public at school functions.
