Teaching and Learning

- It is important that your child engages with Seesaw as new teaching as well as reinforcement work will be taking place.

Work set for your child

- Teachers will be following work planned for the term.
- If your child is having difficulties with their work, please inform your child's teacher.
- If you would like extension activities for your child, you can contact your child's teacher.
- Time will be set each day for your child's teacher to respond to any queries you have and also to give feedback on your child's work.

Online Protocols

- If you have any concerns regarding online materials, please contact your child's teacher or Mrs Watson.

Daily Routines

- Learning will take place each day.
- Children/parents are to log onto Seesaw daily.

- Work will be set for your child which could include: online activities, researching a topic, ICT tasks on the computer (producing slides etc.), written work for literacy, world around us and numeracy, reading and reading tasks ...
