A reminder

The ‘uniform’ from Senior Infants upwards from September 2024 will consist of: *School half-zip, non-crested plain navy tracksuit bottoms and sky blue or royal blue polo shirt. Any type of runners/shoes can be worn.*

Or

Tracksuit as is currently worn with crested navy sweater, sky blue or royal blue polo shirt & non-crested navy tracksuit bottoms.



Half-zips are encouraged (but optional) from Seniors upwards for next year & can only be ordered from B&T Sports, the supplier. B&T Sports will be in school on the following dates to facilitate **sizing, ordering and payment of half-zips.**

Tuesday 11 June from 6.30 to 8.30pm & Thursday 13 June from 2.00 to 4pm

I would recommend you consider buying two and also think about whether you want initials or not (no extra charge). The half-zips cost €35 each and all other parts of the ‘uniform’ can be purchased elsewhere at your discretion.

Some important points to remember:

1. There will be **no** grey school uniform next year.
2. Non-crested plain navy shorts can only be worn in September and in Term 3 after the Easter holidays.
3. Plain navy tracksuit pants/shorts only. No stripes or different colours.
4. We will be asking parents and pupils to cooperate with our efforts to ensure we all wear the correct school ‘uniform’. Strictly plain navy shorts and pants.
