
MONDAY: NEWS

- How?




TUESDAY: SPELLINGS

- Here are some examples: penguins, hippo, snow leopard, lions, flamingos




WEDNESDAY: REPORT WRITING

6. Draw a picture to go with your report




THURSDAY: SUFFIX - ING

- A suffix is one or more syllables added at the end of a word to change its meaning.
- We are going to look at the 'ing' suffix.
- If the word ends in a consonant which is not after a short vowel just add 'ing'.
- For example: jump – jumping , wish – wishing , knock - knocking
- If the word ends in 'e' then you have to take out the 'e' and add ing.
- For example: ride – riding, bite – biting, slide - sliding
- A verb that ends in a consonant after a short vowel you double the last letter and add 'ing'
- For example: hop – hopping, run – running, jog - jogging


















FRIDAY – PROCEDURAL WRITING

- A procedure tells you how to do something.
- This week we are going to make a smoothie or a jam sandwich.
- You get to choose which one you would like to make.
- This is the structure we use for writing a procedure:
 1. Ingredients
 2. Utensils/Equipment
 3. Method



FRIDAY: PROCEDURAL WRITING

- Procedure writing always uses bossy words for example:

1. Put
2. Pour
3. Chop
4. Shake
5. Spread

- If you would like to make the smoothie I have included recipes in the next slide.
- You can add or swap ingredients from the recipe depending on what you like.

Strawberry Smoothie

You will need:

1. 10 strawberries
2. 1 banana
3. 100mililetres of orange juice



Sunshine Smoothie

You will need:

1. 100g pineapple
2. 2 bananas
3. 10g cashew nuts
4. 200mililetres orange juice



Jolly Green Smoothie

You will need:

- 2 cups of spinach
- 1 frozen banana
- 2 kiwi
- ½ avocado
- 1 cup of milk



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
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

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
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GAEILGE
