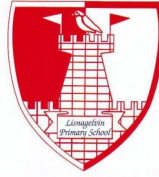

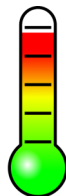


Pupil Sickness and Suspected Cases of Covid-19

I would like to appeal to everyone, if your child is physically sick or has diarrhoea, it is recommended that he/she should be kept off school for 48hrs after the last bout of sickness. We have a number of children in the school who have complex medical issues.

Should a child present with any of the following 3 symptoms (as identified by the Public Health Agency), they will be removed from their 'bubble' and taken directly to the designated isolation room where they will be supervised until a parent collects them.

- **Elevated temperature**
- **Continuous cough**
- **Change in taste/smell**



All siblings will be sent home at the same time. The child displaying the symptoms will then be required to be tested within 48hours. All children in the household should only return to school on confirmation of a negative test. If any member of the household tests positive, then all must adhere to PHA guidance on self-isolation.

Your co-operation on this matter will be much appreciated.

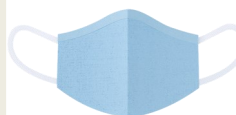
PTA Hallowe'en Disco
