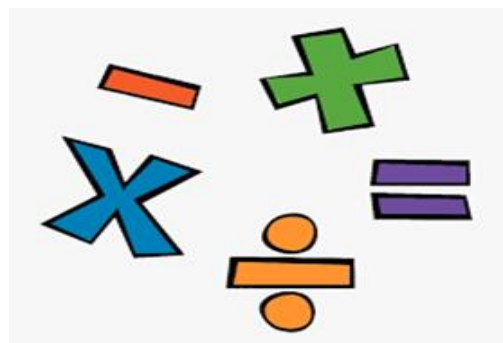

Topics in Maths

Number

- Recognise, add and subtract numbers to 100 and 1000.
- Place value – thousands, hundreds, tens and units (ThHTU)
- Recall times tables. Begin to multiply and divide HTU by numbers less than 10.
- Round numbers to nearest 10 and 100.
- Develop ways to do mental calculation e.g. quick ways to add 9 and 19.
- Identify coins and use money in calculations.

Time

- Calendar work- identifying and adding on days and dates.
- Read and write analogue and digital times.
- Work out time intervals - How long programmes/journeys last.
- Calculate minutes earlier / later. E.g. 30 mins later than...
- Show an understanding of am and pm.

Fractions

- Find fractions of shapes.
- Understand fraction is a part of a whole number.

Half, quarter, thirds, eighths, sixths and twelfths.

Data Handling

- Construct and interpret graphs about themselves (using ICT resources)

Topics in English

- Alphabetical order using the second and third letter.
- Sequencing instructions and stories.
- Cloze procedure- filling in the appropriate words
- Looking at characters, plot and setting in stories.
- Read, write, compare and contrast poems.
- Prepare, read and perform playscripts.

Reading

Through shared, guided and at home:

- Read with increasing fluency, expression and comprehension.
- Answering questions from a variety of texts.
- Discuss plot, storyline and character developments.
- Predict what happens next in the story.
- Finding information and speech in texts.

Grammar

- Basic punctuation including full stops and capital letters.
- Use of comma.
- Identify and use adjectives, verbs and adverbs.
 - Use of suffixes eg -ship, -hood.

Creative Writing

- Recount events from their holidays.
- Write descriptions of characters and mythical creatures.
- Plan and structure a story.
- Poetry writing.
- Edit writing for improvement.
- Write in playscript format.

Talking and Listening

- Follow and relate instructions
- Listen and contribute to group/ class discussions.
