Monday

Spellings - List Twenty - Six: Week Beginning: 4/5/20 - numbers

Mental Maths - Subtract 10 from a 2 digit number within 20

Literacy - Complete Literacy worksheets – Recap on Alphabetical order – Remember look at the first letter and if the first letter is the same move to the second letter etc. (1 or 2 worksheets depending on your child's ability) uploaded on Seesaw – if it is easier please write out answers on a page as handwriting practice is still important. Adjectives – Discuss use of adjectives – words used to describe nouns – complete activities on Seesaw!

IXL Numeracy – Complete some of the IXL targets outlined for Numeracy (E.4, E.6, E.9 and E.10)

Tuesday

Spellings - List Twenty - Six: Week Beginning: 4/5/20 - numbers

Mental Maths - Subtract 10 from a 2 digit number within 20

Numeracy - Complete Numeracy worksheet – Adding 3 numbers – When you are adding 3 numbers together, look for patterns to help make it easier, i.e. start with the biggest number, look for doubles/near doubles, story of 10 etc. e.g. $4 + 6 + 2 =$ (we know $4+6=10$ so then $10+2=12$) Complete worksheets (1 or 2 worksheets depending on your child's ability) uploaded on Seesaw - if it is easier please write out answers on a page as handwriting practice is still important.

IXL Literacy – Complete some of the IXL targets outlined for Literacy (Highlighted on IXL with star)

Purple Mash – Complete activity on Purple mash in “2Do’s” section

Wednesday

Spellings - List Twenty - Six: Week Beginning: 4/5/20 - numbers

Mental Maths - Subtract 10 from a 2 digit number within 20

Literacy - Complete Literacy worksheet – “The goose that laid the Golden Eggs” Comprehension – Read the passage and answer the 10 questions. Please write the answers out on a page separately! Remember be careful with your handwriting and letter formations. Don't forget to use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

IXL Numeracy – Complete some of the IXL targets outlined for Numeracy (X.1, X.2, X.3 and X.4)

Spellings – Spelling Test

Mental Maths – Number test – 10 questions

Numeracy – Complete Numeracy worksheet – Repeated addition – introducing multiplication – $3 \times 2 = 6$ (1 or 2 worksheets depending on your child's ability) uploaded on Seesaw – if it is easier please write out answers on a page as handwriting practice is still important.
