Spellings - List Twenty - Seven: Week Beginning: 11/5/20 - 'd', 'dd', 'ed' Mental Maths - know numbers 'before', 'after' and 'between' within 100

Numeracy – Complete Numeracy worksheet – Repeated addition – we are continuing multiplication – 4×2 (4 multiplied by 2) is really saying "4 groups of 2" which we know is 2 + 2 + 2 + 2 = 8 (complete 1 or 2 worksheets depending on your child's ability) uploaded on Seesaw – if it is easier please write out answers on a page as handwriting practice is still important. Lots of practical work first is recommended so your child can physically see what is happening to the amount as the numbers increase.

Mental Maths – know numbers 'before', 'after' and 'between' within 100

Literacy - Complete Literacy worksheet — Recap on reciting the alphabetical from last week — Following on from alphabetical order last week we are learning how to use a dictionary. If we were in school, we would be using a real picture dictionary. If you have one you could do some practical work to begin with. Then answer the questions on Looking at a dictionary uploaded on Seesaw (only answer what you can) — Write out answers on a page as handwriting practice is still important.
