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This is an outline of your weekly home learning activities that you can complete in your own time each week. Remember that this is only a guide – do what is best for your child.

Monday – 11.5.20.

Spellings – These are your spellings for the week, they are homophones:

(there, their, they're, your, you're, cellar, seller, cite, site, where, wear, were, allowed & aloud)

Check, cover and write each spelling for practise.

Mental Maths – Seesaw – Number Sequences and Rules.

Literacy and Reading – Seesaw -The 'BFG' Task.

Numeracy – Seesaw – Algebra - Generate Expressions.

Art and Design – Make a model from recyclable materials. You have all week to finish your model.

You could make a robot, a car or a house etc. Share your creations on Seesaw on or before Friday!

Wednesday – 13.5.20.

Spellings – Write each of your spellings in a sentence. Ensure it makes sense!

Mental Maths – Seesaw – Number Sequences and Place Value.

Literacy and Reading – Comprehension questions 1-15. Spelling, Vocabulary and Punctuation.

Numeracy – Seesaw – Algebra – Word Problems.

Geography – Pick a country you don't know very much about. Carry out some research on the country and produce a fact file for it. You could include facts such as the capital city, population and landmarks etc. Aim for at least 10 interesting facts!

Thursday – 14.5.20.

Spellings – Write each spelling in a sentence with its homophone. Don't get confused!

For example: 'You're going to be very tired during your music recital'.

Mental Maths – Seesaw – Rounding and Estimation.

Literacy and Reading – Seesaw – Memories Activity – Instructions are on Seesaw (one week to complete).

Numeracy – Seesaw - Algebra – Calculating Expressions.

Friday – 15.5.20.

Spellings – Spelling test – Ask a parent/carer/guardian to call out each of your words. How many did you get correct? Show me on Seesaw! (Don't worry, no one else can see your score!)

Mental Maths and Numeracy – Test day – Complete the test either on Seesaw or a page.

Literacy and Reading – Seesaw – Spelling and Vocabulary.

PE – Sports Day Practise – Arrange some events in a safe area around your house. These events could include short sprints, longer runs, long jump, high jump, three legged race, egg and soon race and wheelbarrow races etc. Practise each event and take pictures to share with us on Seesaw. You could also race a sibling or parent/guardian for fun!
