Matisse Inspired Coral Reef Art

You will need:

- A range of brightly coloured paper and /or tissue paper
- A large sheet of plain white paper, such as A3 paper (to use as your canvas)

Equipment:

- Scissors
- Glue



Instructions

- 1. Use your large sheet of plain white paper as your canvas.
- 2. Cut large and bold coral reef shapes from different coloured paper or tissue paper.
- 3. Layer and overlap these shapes onto your canvas so that they make a bright coral reef scene.
- 4. Next, cut out shapes of sea creatures, such as fish, starfish and octopuses.
- 5. Position these shapes amongst the coral reef shapes on your canvas.
- 6. When you are happy with your under the sea picture, use glue to stick your shapes in place.
