Spellings – No new spellings this week. Revise all the spellings on the list

Mental Maths – Count forwards in 2's from different starting EVEN numbers within 100.

Literacy – First Go through the Palm Sunday PowerPoint on Twinkl. Complete Literacy worksheet on Palm Sunday (1 or 2 worksheets depending on your child's ability) uploaded on Seesaw – draw and record yourself.

Reading – Big Cat Reading Scheme (see link on the website). (Diamonds age 5-7 Emeralds age 7-9 Sapphires age 9-11) complete activities. This is only a guide for you to provide some additional reading material.

Numeracy - Complete Numeracy worksheet – Subtracting without regrouping (1 or 2 pages depending on your child's ability) uploaded on Seesaw - if it is easier please write out answers on a page or print out as handwriting practice is still important.
