Spellings - List Twenty-Four: Week Beginning: 20/4/20 - 'ay' and 'ai'

Mental Maths - Count backwards in 2's from different starting even numbers, within 100

Literacy - Complete Literacy worksheets – Phonics "ai/ay" worksheet (1 or 2 worksheets depending on your child's ability) uploaded on Seesaw – if it is easier please write out answers on a page as handwriting practice is still important. Adjectives – Discuss use of adjectives – words used to describe nouns – complete activities on Seesaw!

Spellings - List Twenty-Four: Week Beginning: 20/4/20 - 'ay' and 'ai'

Mental Maths - Count backwards in 2's from different starting even numbers, within 100

Numeracy - Complete Numeracy worksheet – Recap on 2D Shape extending to finding fractions of shapes e.g. $\frac{1}{2}$ = split in 2 equal parts and $\frac{1}{4}$ = split in 4 equal parts (1 or 2 worksheets depending on your child's ability) uploaded on Seesaw - if it is easier please write out answers on a page as handwriting practice is still important.
