Monday - 27.4.20.

Spellings – Select any spellings that you find challenging. They don't need to be from your Spelling Bee booklet. Look, cover and write each of these words for practise.

Mental Maths – Seesaw Activity – Day 1 challenge cards - Time yourself answering all three cards. **Literacy** and **Reading** – Seesaw activity – Sigurd the Dragon Slayer – Comprehension (read and revise task).

Numeracy – Seesaw activity – Counting and drawing lines of symmetry.

Tuesday - 28.4.20.

Spellings – Can you write each of your chosen spellings in a sentence? Challenge: relate the topic of each sentence to something positive which has happened to you lately.

Mental Maths – Seesaw Activity – Day 2 challenge cards - Time yourself answering all three cards. **Literacy** and **Reading** – Seesaw activity – Howling Wolves - Comprehension (find a simile or

metaphor).

Numeracy – Seesaw activity – Reflective symmetry – drawing shapes/shading squares.

Wednesday - 29.4.20.

Spellings – Can you write a dictionary definition for each of your chosen words?

Mental Maths – Seesaw activity – Day 3 challenge cards – Time yourself answering all three cards.

Literacy and Reading – Seesaw activity – Shaka Zulu – Comprehension (personification poem).

Numeracy – Seesaw activity – Word problems – Multi-operations.

Thursday - 30.4.20.

Spellings – Count the number of letters in each of your chosen words. Can you write two more words with the same number of letters? For example: 'animal' contains 6 letters – 'adults' and 'beauty' also contain 6 letters. Do this for each of your words.

Mental Maths - Call out the 6 times tables in order - time yourself.

Literacy and **Reading** – Seesaw activity – My Good Luck, Bad Luck Gran – Comprehension (Colons and Semi-Colons).

Creative Writing – Seesaw Activity - Interview with an adult – Superstitions.

Numeracy - Seesaw activity - Word problems - Money.

Friday - 1.5.20.

Spellings – Spelling test – Ask a parent/carer/guardian to call out each of your words. How many did you get correct? Show me on Seesaw!
