Mental Maths – Know near doubles to 10+10 e.g if 4+4=8 then 4+5=9.

Numeracy - Complete Numeracy worksheet — Recap on the terms place value, tens and units. Today we are subtracting with 'regrouping'. This is new and should be a practical activity using a page or whiteboard. In school we use base 10 materials of rods and units to represents tens and units. You can use anything else similar e.g straws to represents tens and perhaps little sweets to represent the units. Place an amount of units on the table, children must exchange a group of 10 for a rod e.g. 23 units = 2 tens and 3 units Template included. this is new for P3).. This is a step further from before Easter. NB We don't call it ones like they do in this demonstration. We call them units. The Tens and Units column.
