


Order of operations

Put brackets round the calculations you do first.



Remember to do the multiplication or division first.

1. $6 - 12 \div 4 =$

2. $7 + 1 \times 6 =$

3. $9 \times 1 + 10 =$

4. $12 - 5 \times 2 =$

5. $1 \times 9 + 9 =$

6. $8 \times 10 - 7 =$

7. $9 - 8 \div 8 =$

8. $3 + 2 \times 11 =$

9. $12 \div 3 + 2 =$

10. $4 \times 4 - 3 =$

11. $6 + 12 \times 2 =$

12. $4 \times 5 - 4 =$

13. $12 \times 8 + 7 =$

14. $12 + 3 \times 5 =$

15. $5 + 8 \times 10 =$

16. $10 \div 2 + 11 =$

17. $7 - 1 \times 3 =$

18. $4 + 48 \div 8 =$
