COVID 19 Testing

We are hoping to roll out testing over the coming weeks starting with a small group of pupils and staff then rolling it out across the school. It will happen on a weekly basis, every Thursday.

Information is attached along with this newsletter. Please note that you **must** complete a signed consent form (paper version) before your child can be tested, these will be sent home this week.

Tests are carried out by you at home, there is a video included in the information demonstrating how to carry out the test on your son/daughter. It is available to all pupils who attend school on a Thursday. The cut off time for tests to be in school is 10am.

Sickness

Please remember that if your son/daughter is ill not to send them into school, particularly in the current climate.

If your son/daughter requires a COVID test at a testing centre, please inform us immediately. If the test comes back negative they should remain at home until they are well enough to return. In the event that they display non-COVID symptoms it is recommended that they remain at home for 3 days after their last symptom.

Please phone school on the first day of absence.

Old Jumpers

Do you have old school jumpers at home? Please send them in to school if you no longer have a use for them.

Some of our staff have been creatively repurposing old jumpers as covers for our pupils for lunch time, painting, messy play.
