- make sure you have the best life chances and can grow up happy and successful




How?

- if anyone shouts, threatens, hits or hurts someone you love which makes you scared, unhappy or worried.
- if someone doesn't take proper care of you
- if someone touches you in places that are wrong
- if someone makes you look at or do things which make you feel uncomfortable
