Applications for admission to Primary 1 in September 2019 will be completed digitally this year. Parents will apply through a **Parent Portal**: A new portal for parents to apply online for a place, including the listing of preferences.

The new Digital Admissions process will go live on **Wednesday 2 January at 10am** and will close at 12 midnight on **Thursday 31 January 2019**. This replaces the current paper-based application form.

## Values of the Month


Our "Value of the Month" for December is CHARITY
