

Good Friday Paper Plate Pop-Up

You will need:

Paper plate

Pencil

Paints or felt-tip pens

Scissors

Cross Template

Glue

White, brown or black card



Instructions

1. Turn your paper plate upside down on a table.
2. Use scissors to cut half way around the edge of the centre circle on the paper plate.
3. Once cut, fold it back so that a semi-circle pops up.
4. Use paints or felt pens to decorate the paper plate. It should look like Calvary, the hill outside of Jerusalem where Jesus was crucified. Perhaps you could also include the stone tomb where he was laid after he died.
5. Next, draw around the cross template on to the card. You will need to do this three times.
6. Cut the crosses out of the card. Stick each cross to the pop-up hill.
7. You might like to write an Easter message around the edge of the paper plate.
