



Cut out the birthday treats. Count out the amount you need and share them between your two friends. Write in the box how many treats they each got.






Maths – Shape, Space and Measures – Complex Repeating Patterns








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Practical Ideas – Maths, Phonics and Lockdown Live Activity

Activity Outcomes

• Your child will learn how to share objects equally between two.

Setting up

What you will need

- A picture of two ice creams (or two bowls can be used to count into)
- Pom poms or other small items that can be counted.
- Playing cards with only even numbers selected

Activity Guide

Activity – Share the Objects

- The child chooses a playing card and identifies how many there are.
- They count out that many pom poms.
- They share the pom poms one at a time onto the ice cream scoop until there are none left.
- The child then counts how many are on each ice cream.
- Encourage the child to repeat the sentence: '___pom poms shared between 2 ice creams is ___pom poms on each ice cream'.

Questions you could ask your child during the activity

- How many pom poms are on each ice cream?
- How many are there altogether?

Further Support and Ideas

- Children could share between a greater number.
- Children could share odd numbers to see what happens.
