To show support for the Tyrone Team we will be having a 'Tyrone Non Uniform Day' on Friday so all pupils are encouraged to wear 'red and white' to school.

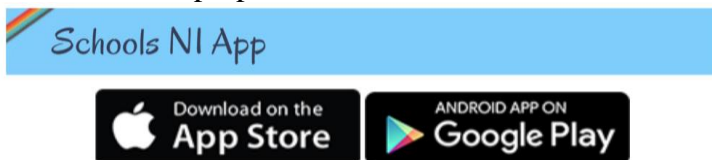
