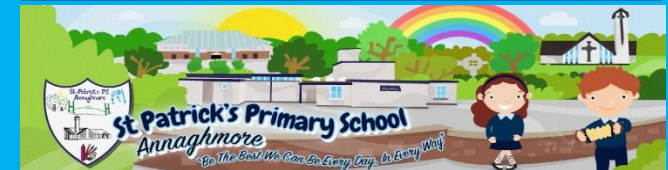
Sport
