Dear Parent / Guardian,

I am writing to advise you that the Education Authority (EA) have notified all schools today, that members of the three Non-Teaching unions (UNITE the Union, GMB and NIPSA) are being called to take part in strike action across a number of days in May and June in relation to a trade dispute linked to the EA Pay and Grading Review. Members include bus drivers, school catering staff, classroom assistants, cleaners and other support workers. This is a dispute between Non -Teaching unions and the employers; it is not a dispute with the school.

The Non - Teaching unions are planning to take industrial action on the following dates:

- Monday 20th May 2024
- Tuesday 21st May 2024
- Wednesday 22nd May (NIPSA <u>BUS DRIVERS</u> & UNITE THE UNION MEMBERS ONLY)
- Monday 3rd June 2024
- Tuesday 4th June 2024

The action by **GMB and NIPSA** will result in disruption to normal school provision. Where staff have elected to take lawful industrial action, we will have no choice but to take appropriate steps to ensure the health, safety and wellbeing of all pupils.

We know that strike action is an inconvenience to parents and so I am writing to give you advance notice of the likely impact of the action on St Mary's.

If the action does go ahead, the following arrangements will be in place.

The school will be open all day on 20th May, 21st May, 22nd May, 3rd June, 4th June. You may experience a disruption to EA home to school transport. Pupils who are supported by a classroom assistant may experience reduced provision. The school cook has informed me that the school kitchen will <u>not</u> operate on Monday 20th May, Tuesday 21st May, Monday 3rd June, Tuesday 4th June and therefore pupils are required to bring a packed lunch (<u>this includes pupils in receipt of free school meals</u>). The school kitchen <u>will</u> operate on Wednesday 22nd May.
