What happens if a child or member of the family develop symptoms that are linked to Covid-19?

- Stay at home
- Ensure you get a test
- The family must remain in isolation whilst they wait for the test result.
- Negative result? - contact the school.
- Has the school received information on the result? Yes - your child can return to school.
- Positive result? - contact the school immediately. Family will need to follow the advice from Test, Trace and Protect (TTP). School will follow protocol from the local authority.
