Message from the school nurse

Re: Nasal Spray Flu Vaccine Reception – Year 6

_This year, if a child was absent on the day the school nursing team had visited to offer the nasal spray flu vaccine, we will not be sending letters to parents/guardians advising them to hand it in at their GP practice when they arrange for their child to receive the vaccination. This is due to current IP&C advice on handling of paper.

Would be grateful if you could please advise all parents/guardians, via the school website, that if their child was absent when their 'class bubble' was vaccinated, but they consented to the vaccination, they need to arrange with their GP practice for their child to be vaccinated.

If a whole 'class bubble' was off isolating on advice, due to a positive Covid test, can you please advise those parents that we will be arranging to provide a 'catch up' session

(School nurse rang today - they were due to be here next Tuesday but will now come in on Monday)

What if you or a member of your family tests positive for covid?

It is important that you let us know so we can help track and trace let others know if they have had contact.
