### Sports Day

### Covid Cases

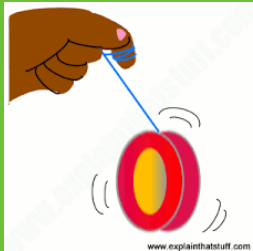

### HWB Logins

Every child has a login for HWB and parents can use it to see work the children are doing and any reports that teacher sends. Hwb also has many other features that parents can use with their child. The account belongs to the child but it is important that parents access it regularly. Homework will be on hwb too. Hwb was not just for lockdown. Teachers have provided parents with all the log in details. Suggestions on where to keep these details rather than go into a last minute panic when reports are sent or the child has homework to do:

- ask your child - children from year 2 up tend to log on every day in school.
- take a screen shot and save it to your phone
- put the details into your notes on your phone
- write them onto a sticky note and selotape it to your device
- paper onto fridge door
- stick them on the back of your child's bedroom door
- text them to yourself



### What's all this with the yoyos?

All the children took part in a live virtual show about 'growth mindset'; never giving up, encouraging others and always doing your best. The idea of learning to use a yoyo demonstrates how we encourage children to become determined and believe in themselves. We have been surprised how excited the children were to start practising.
