It has been a positive and real asset for the school and we have received a huge amount of thanks and recognition for this. As a staff we too have recognised the benefits it has brought for your children and this was discussed during our INSET days. We have made a decision that all these methods of communication will remain. Class teachers / teaching assistants will continue to make regular contact with families so please do not be concerned if you receive these calls. If you do not wish to receive any 'check in' calls please let us know.

New Covid rules - Please keep the virus out of our school

As we know, the rules have changed so many times. Sometimes we understand them and sometimes we don't, but they are still rules for us to follow. We do have our own opinions but we still have to follow the rules. As you know from the community, schools are now facing different circumstances. We understand that these new arrangements may cause you concern. Social media and press are already stating strong views. As a school, we have to follow legal instruction. As a school, we continue to ask that you consider and respect the safety of all pupils and staff. We have a duty of care to all pupils, but we will need to pay particular attention to those who are vulnerable and have been shielded due to medical conditions. We have pupils with serious medical conditions and I know that you would want to help us protect them. We are happy to discuss each case individually so both your family, and all our families feel safe. Many thanks for your support.

PE kits

We are now able to remove the teaching areas from the hall. This means that the gymnastics sessions can return and all areas of physical education can return. Each class will have separate sessions for PE and we create a timetable for classes to use the hall. Teachers will let you know what day your child needs to bring their kit into school and if they need trainers or jogging bottoms. PE kits are plain white t-shirt (no logos), plain black shorts or jogging bottoms depending on lesson type. It is important that we ensure the children have plain garments without logos. I am sure you will understand the reasons why and they can be purchased relatively cheap from many stores these days! Thank you in anticipation for your support.

Handover at the end of day

We collect information on who is picking your child up from school. Your child will not be handed to anyone else unless we are told by you. If there is a change of person for whatever reason, you must let us know. These rules are in place to make sure we know your child is safe. Parents of year 5 & 6 pupils are offered the chance for their children to walk home alone. Parents make that decision for their own child knowing that they have put safety measures in place.
