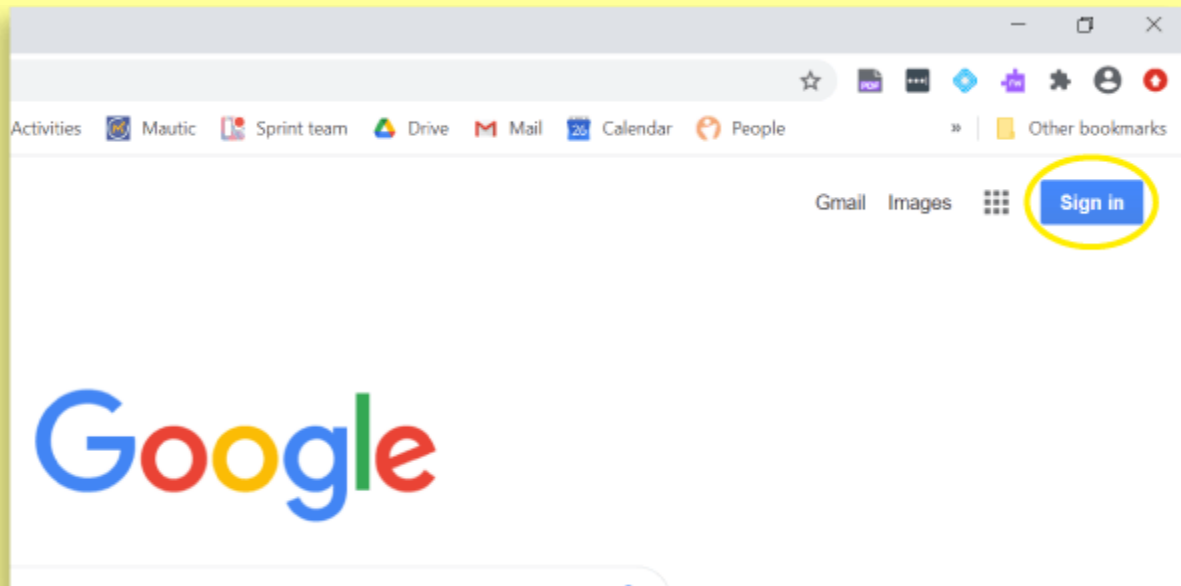
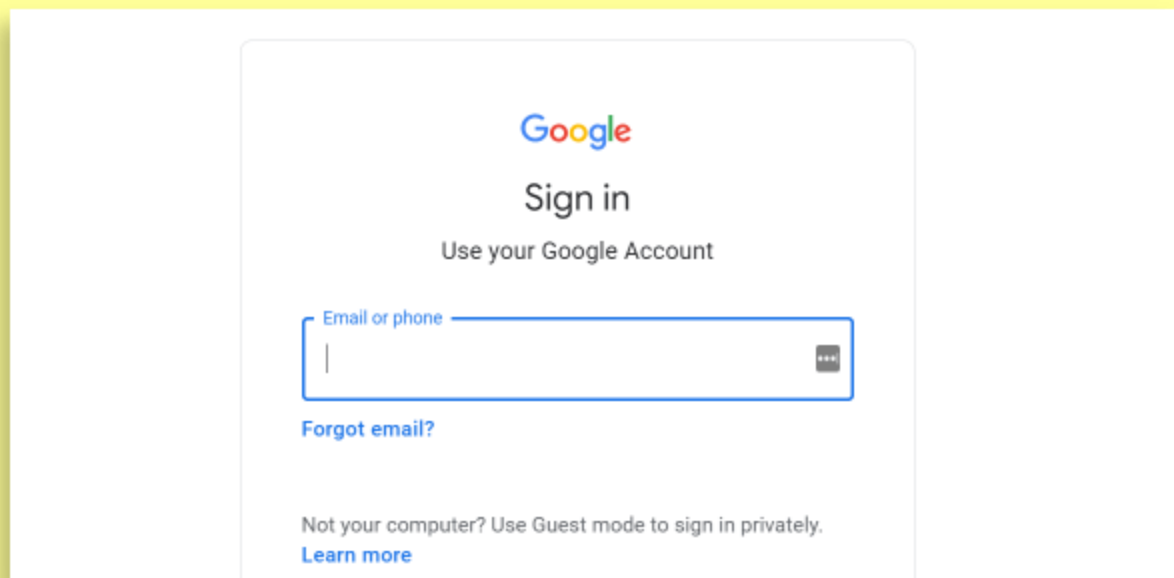


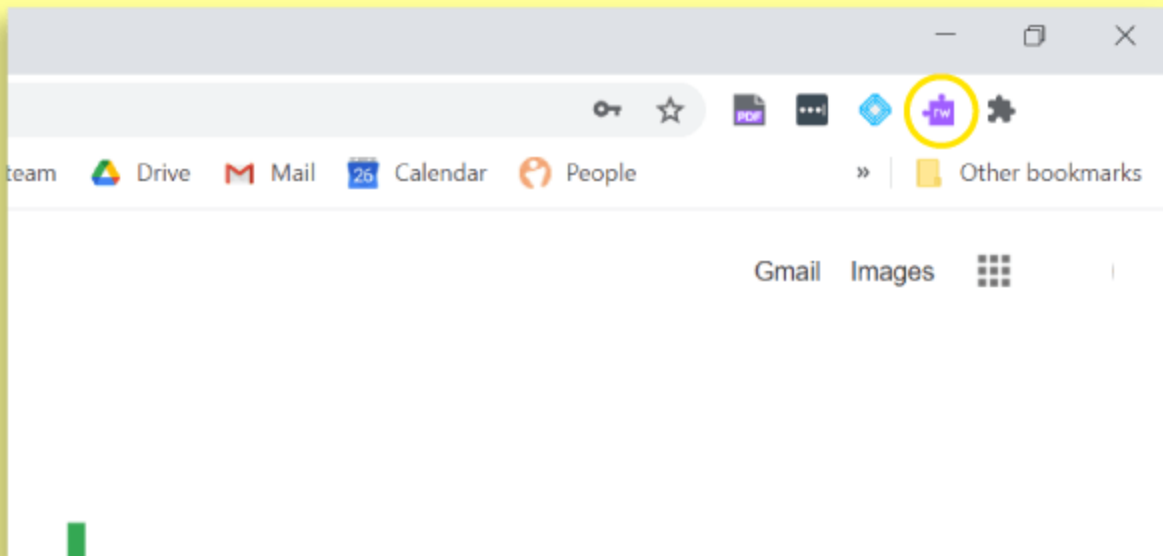
Follow the steps below to start using Read&Write for Google Chrome at home or on a stand-alone school device, such as a Chromebook:



1. Open the Google Chrome browser. Using your C2K school email address (@c2ken) and password, sign in to Google Chrome.

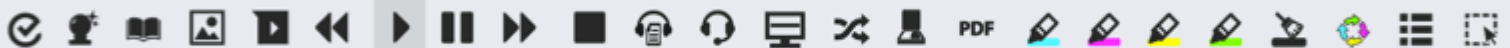


2. Click on 'sign in' in the top right corner. Then enter your C2K email (e.g. jbloggs123@c2ken.net), followed by password.



3. Click on the purple Read&Write puzzle piece icon in the top right corner of the Chrome browser. You will need to [visit the chrome store](#) first to install the 'Read and Write for Google Chrome extension', by simply clicking 'Add to Chrome'. If you're having trouble finding the Read&Write icon within your browser, [watch this video](#) to find out how to easily locate Chrome extensions.

If you're asked to log in to Read&Write, use your same email address and password as before.



4. The toolbar will appear on screen, ready to be used. It can be used on any website or **on-line** document, such as, Google docs, Word on-line docs etc.
