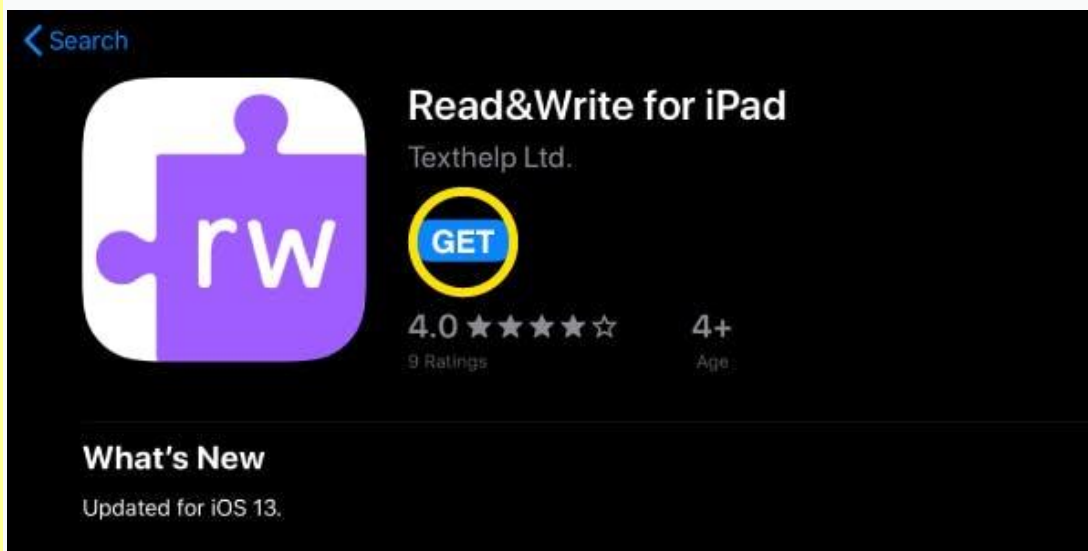


[Follow the steps below to start using Read&Write for iPad at home.](#)

Select the iPad icon and this will bring you to the Apple Store.

*You can also go straight to the App Store and search for 'Read&Write for iPad'.*

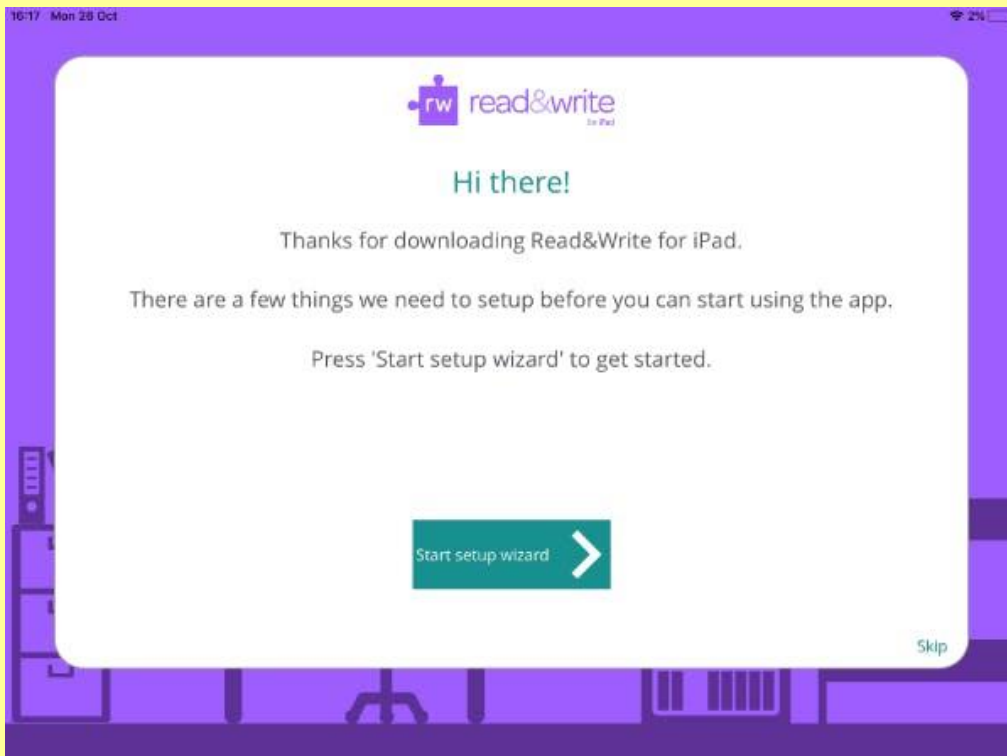


Click 'GET' to download and install the app.

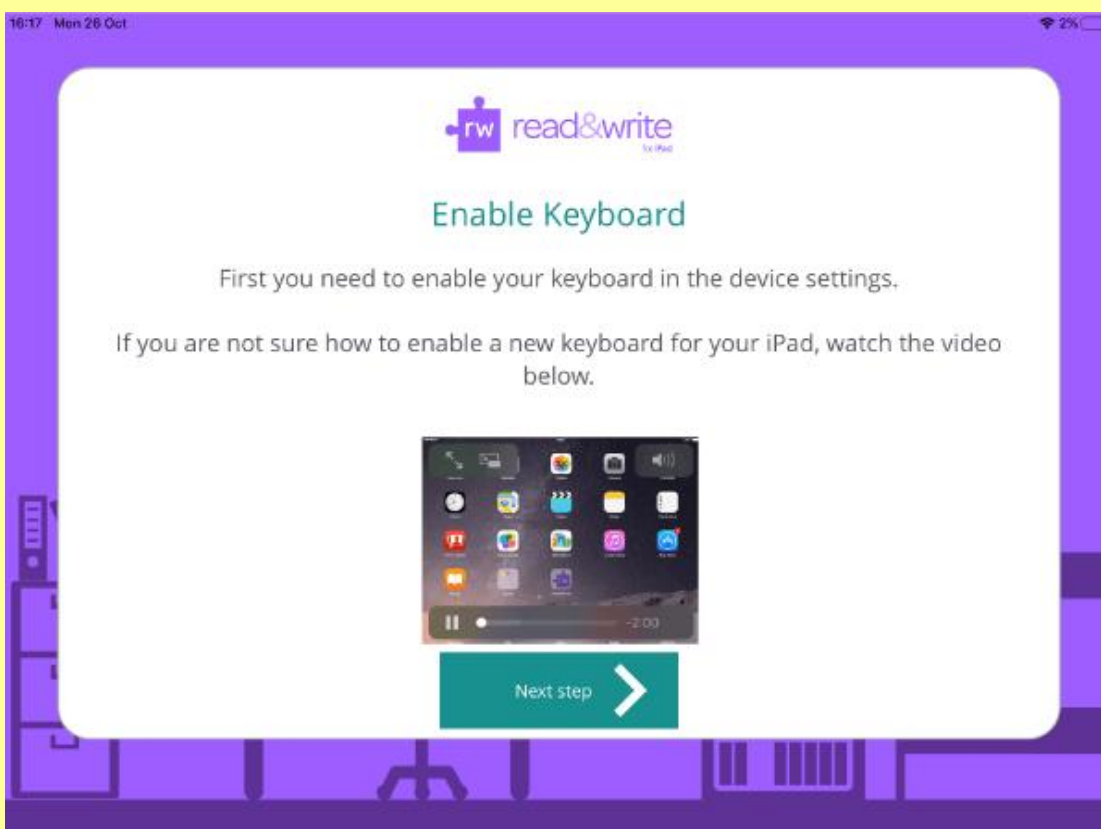
### Getting the app set up



On your home screen, tap the purple Read&Write puzzle piece icon to open the app.



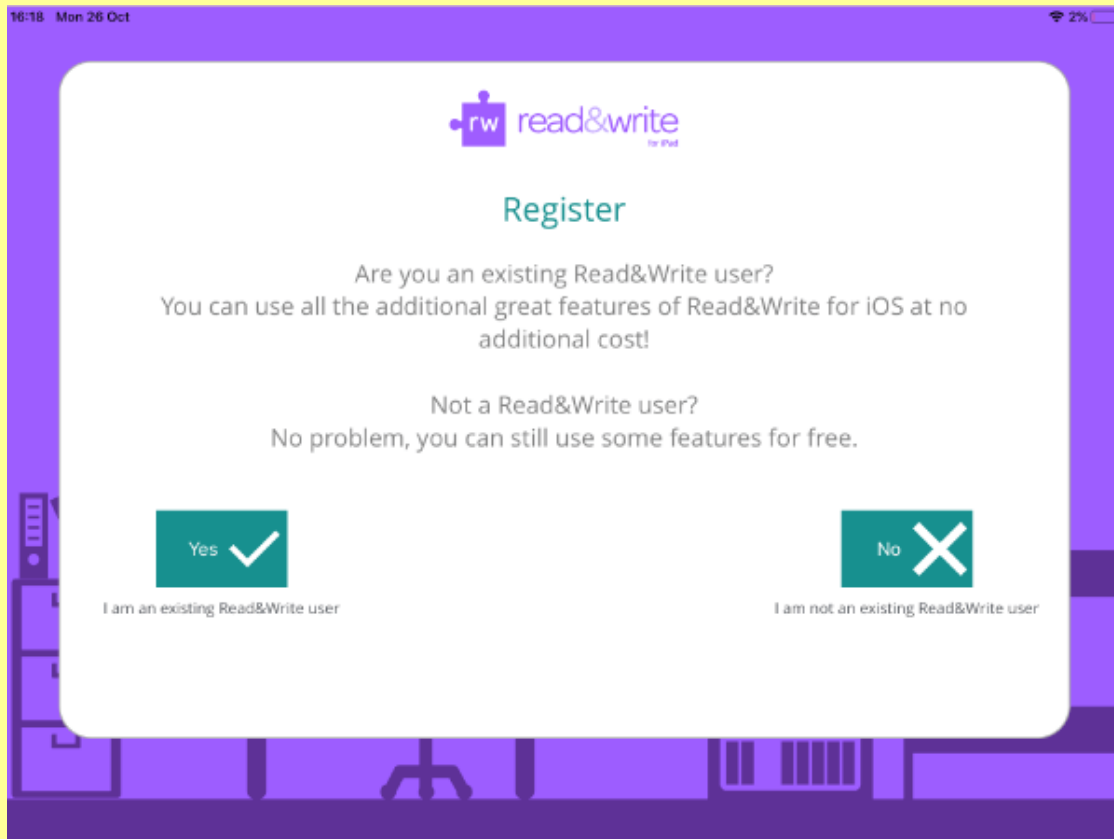
A welcome message will appear, click 'Start setup wizard'. First, you need to enable the keyboard in your iPad settings.



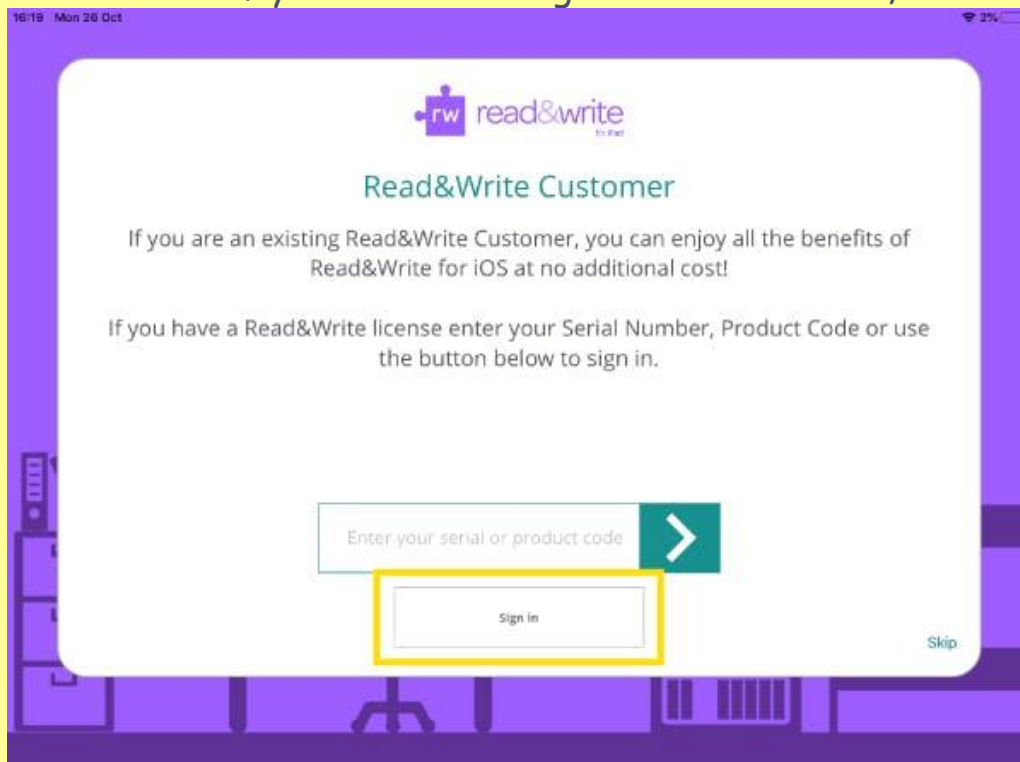
Once you've installed the Read&Write keyboard on your iPad, return to the Read&Write app to continue setup by clicking 'next step'.

Now you need to register

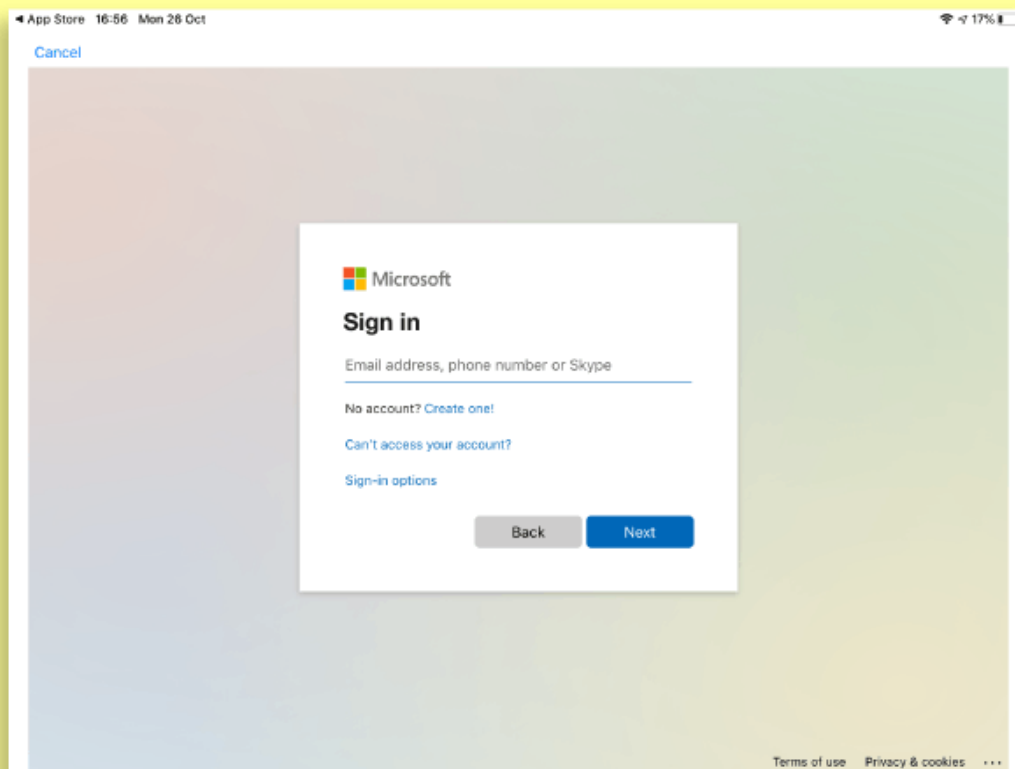
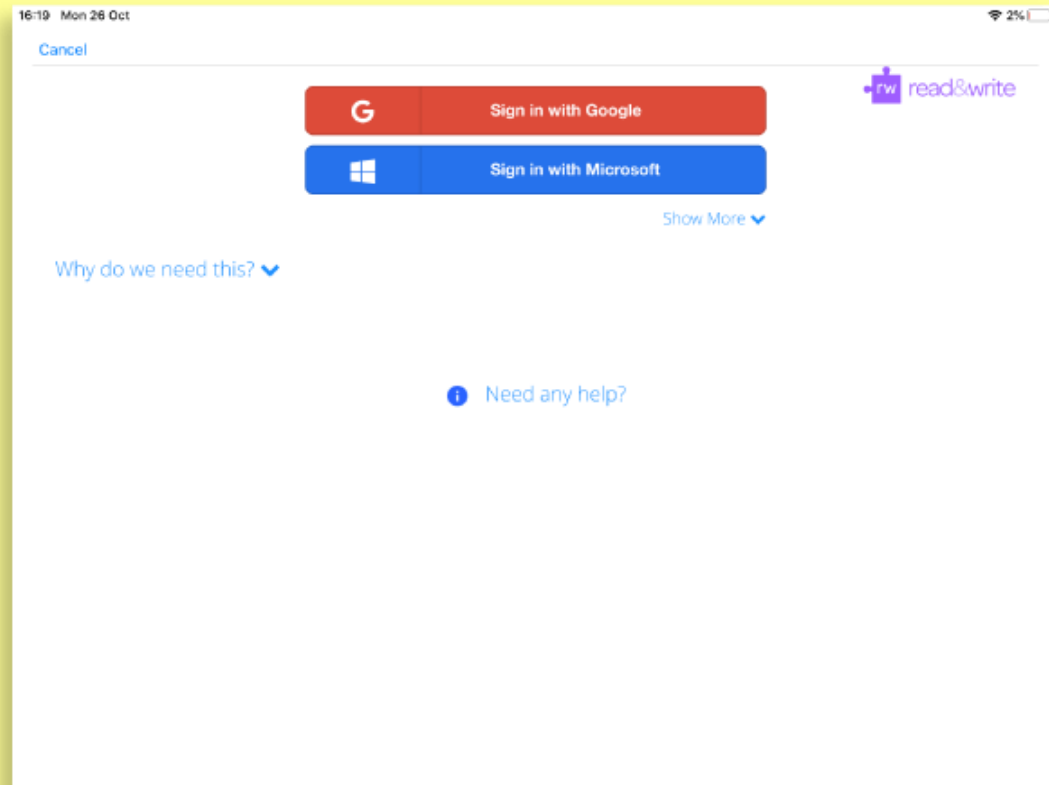


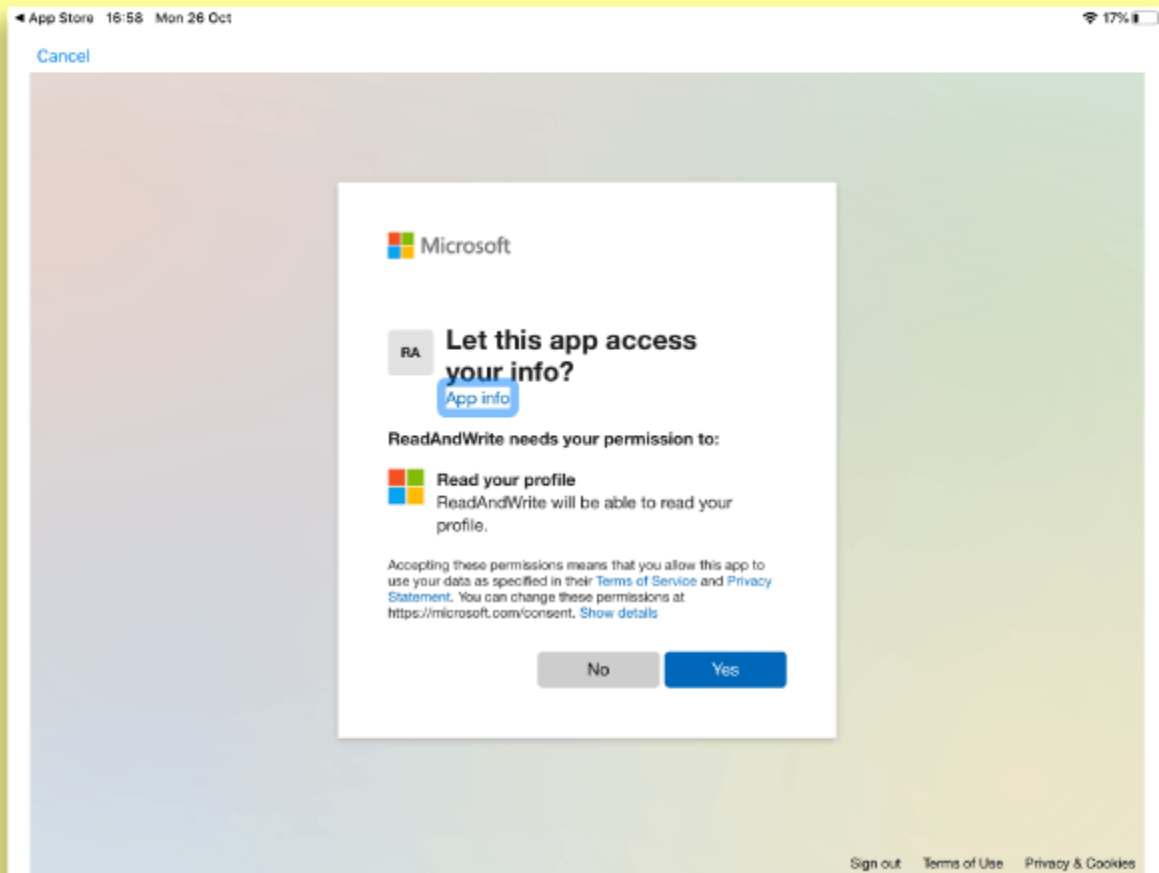
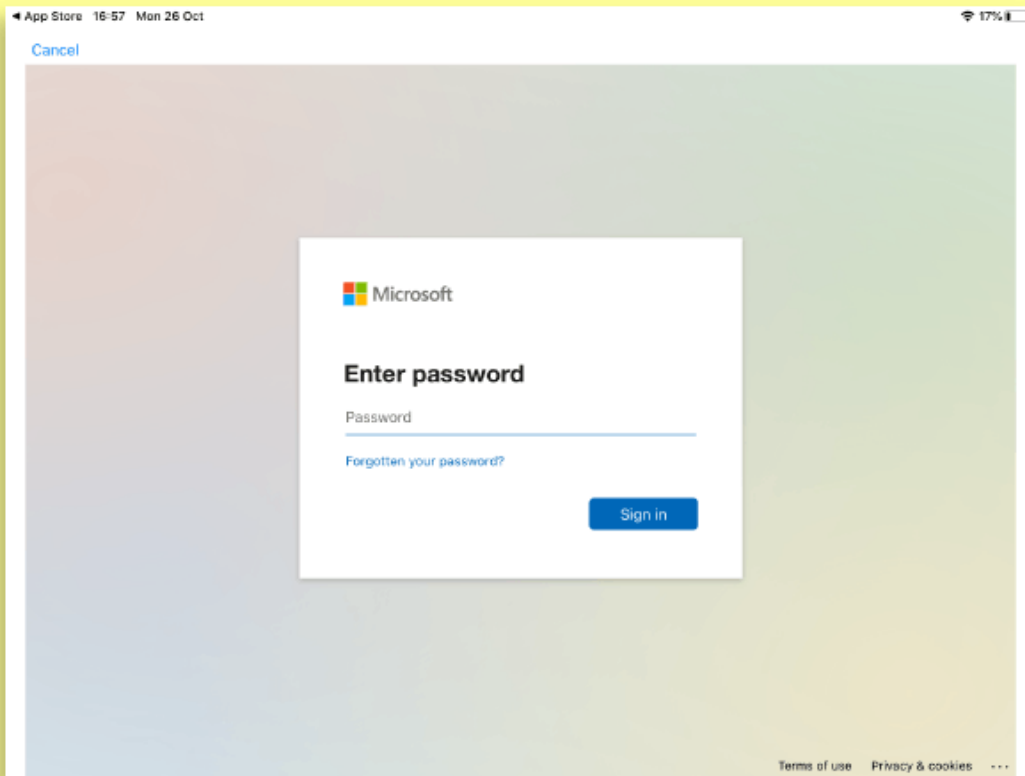
When asked if you're an existing Read&Write user, click 'Yes'.

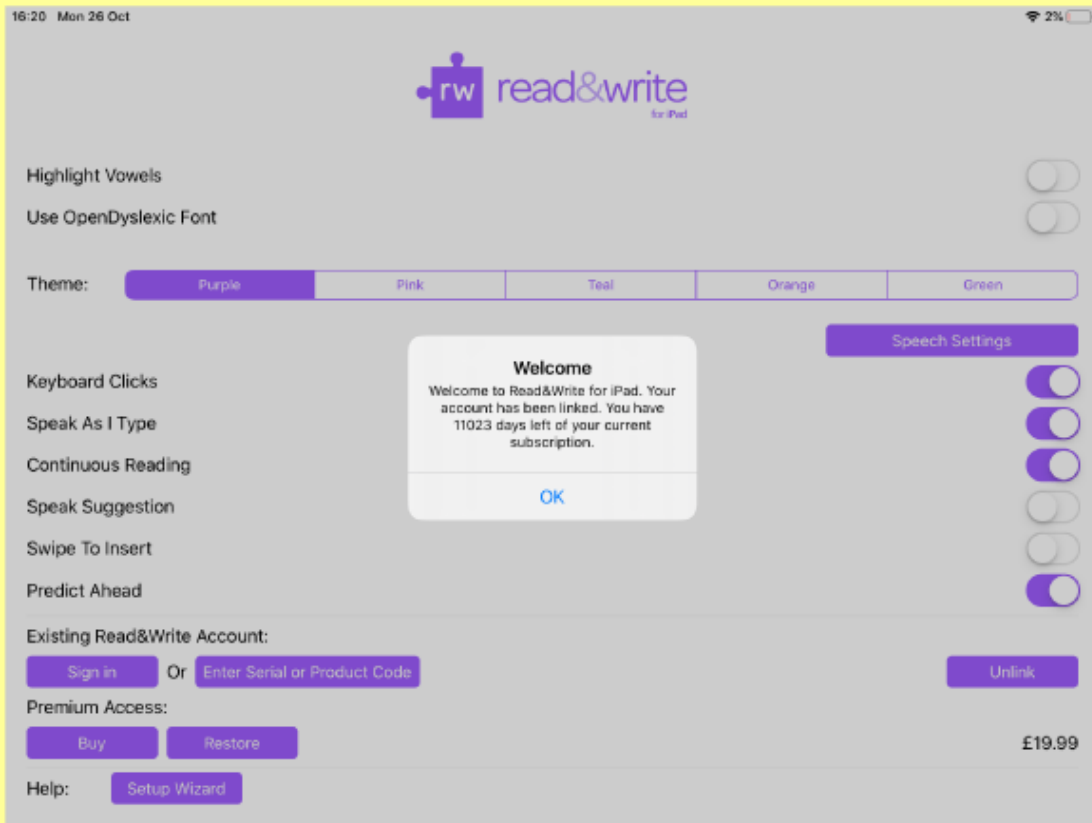


On the next screen, simply press the 'sign in' button. You do not need a product code.

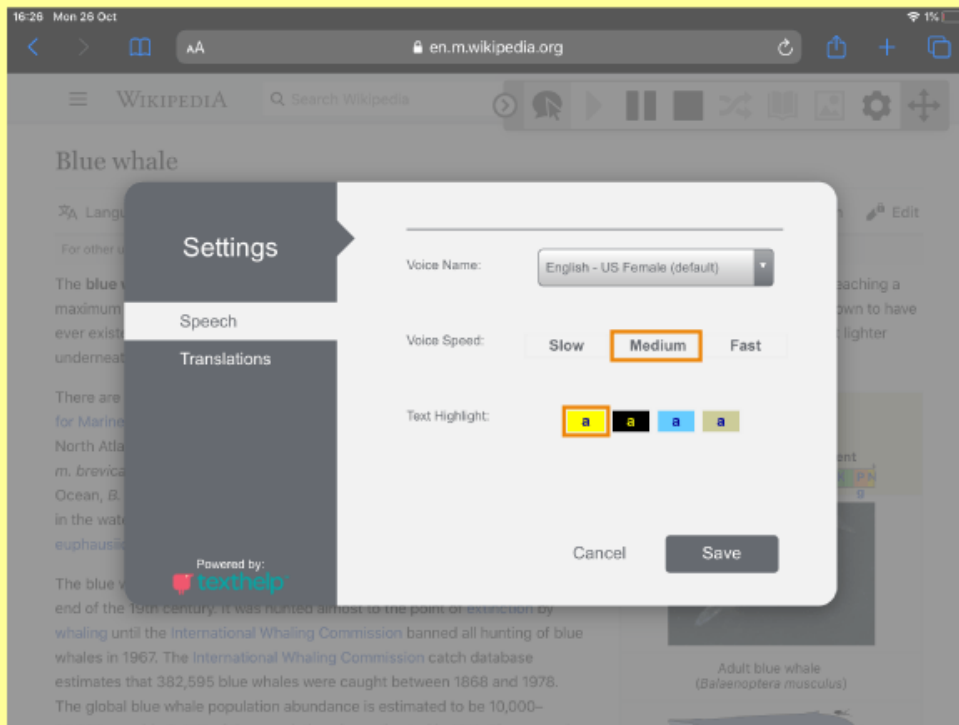
Choose to sign in with Microsoft using your C2K school email address (e.g. jbloggs123@c2ken.net).
