Over the past month the children and staff have been discussing what they have in their lunch boxes. The discussions have shown that children are bringing in great healthy lunch, however, many are not eating everything they are given in their lunch box.

In order to ensure families are not going to expense buying food that goes uneaten, we have put in place some rules to help the children with eating their lunch. It will also help parents see what is being eaten and which items are not:

1. If we find that your child is not eating items in their packed lunch we encourage them to bring it home for you to discuss this with them.
 2. Pupils should eat their own lunch and never swap food.
 3. Children are encouraged to eat sandwiches first.
