Reading

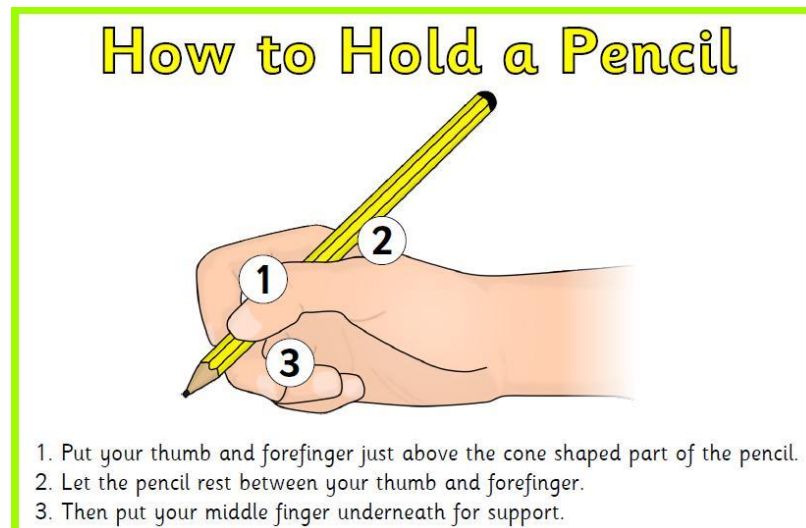
New words for this week - one two green
