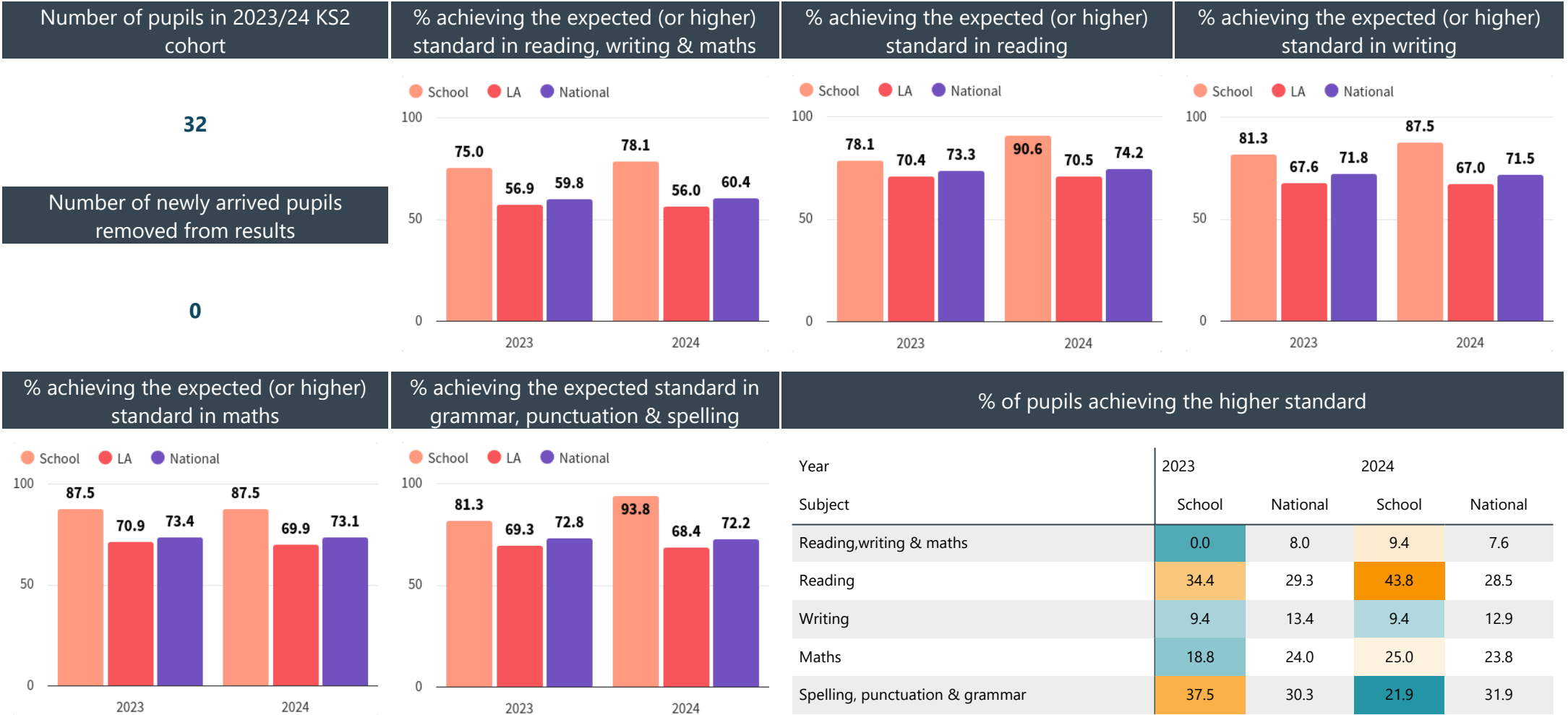


About this report

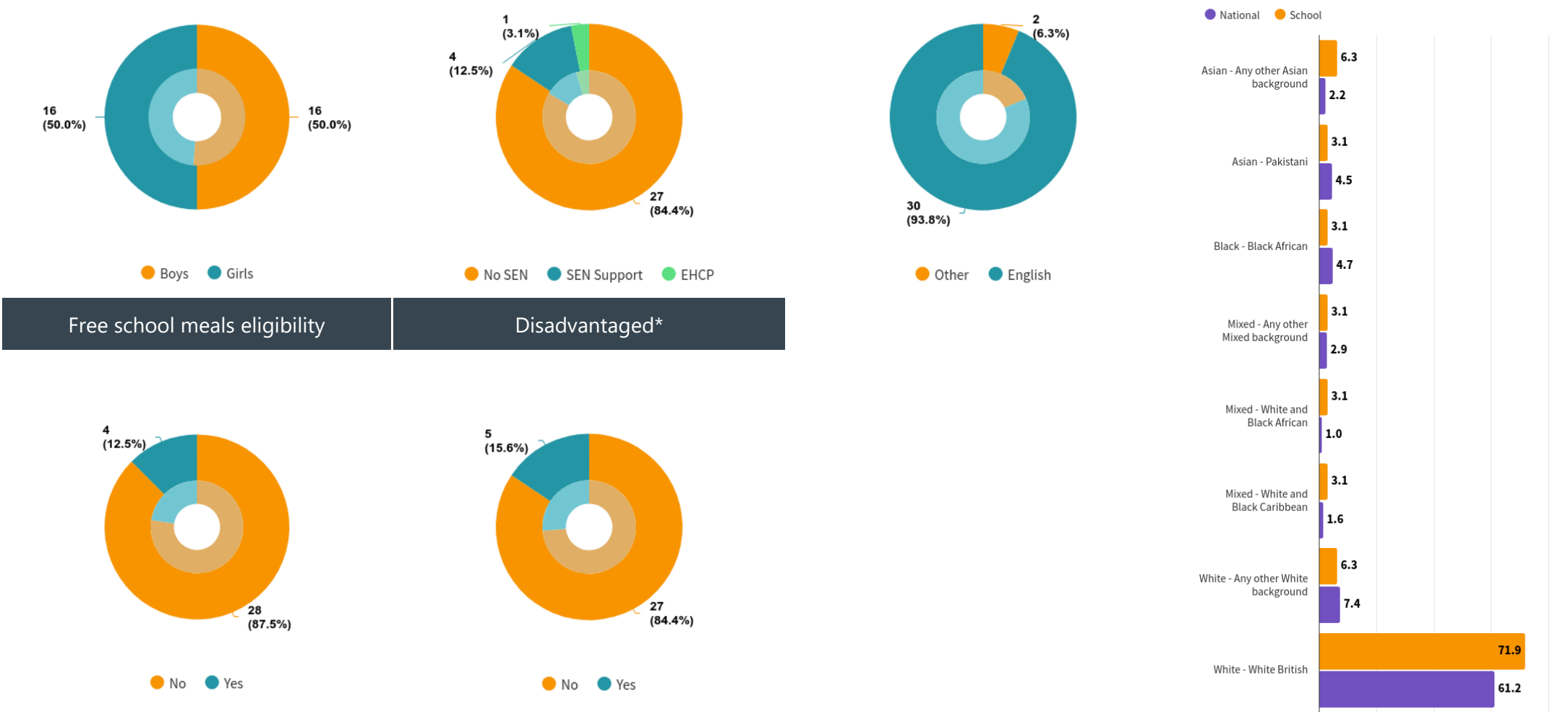

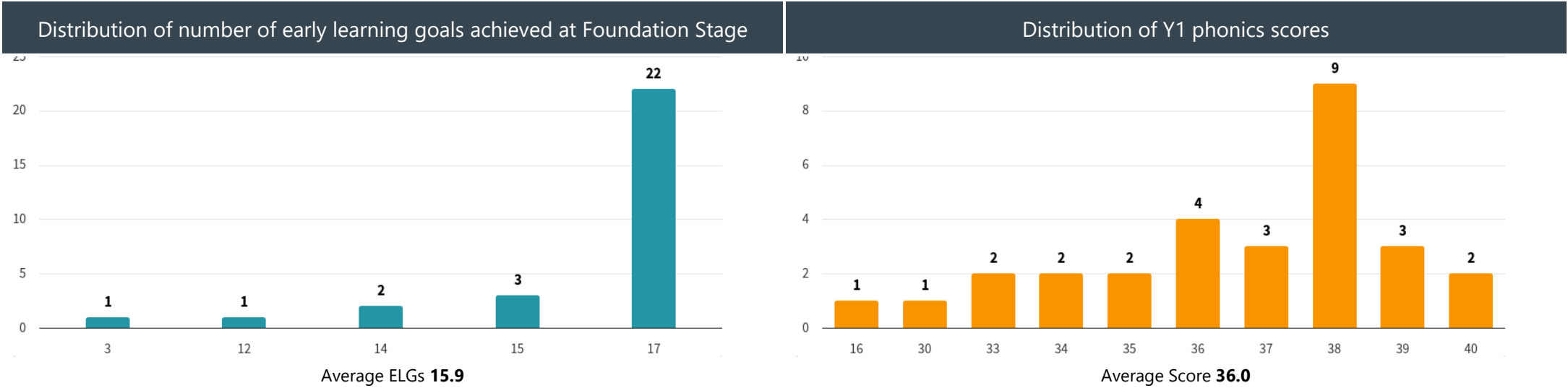
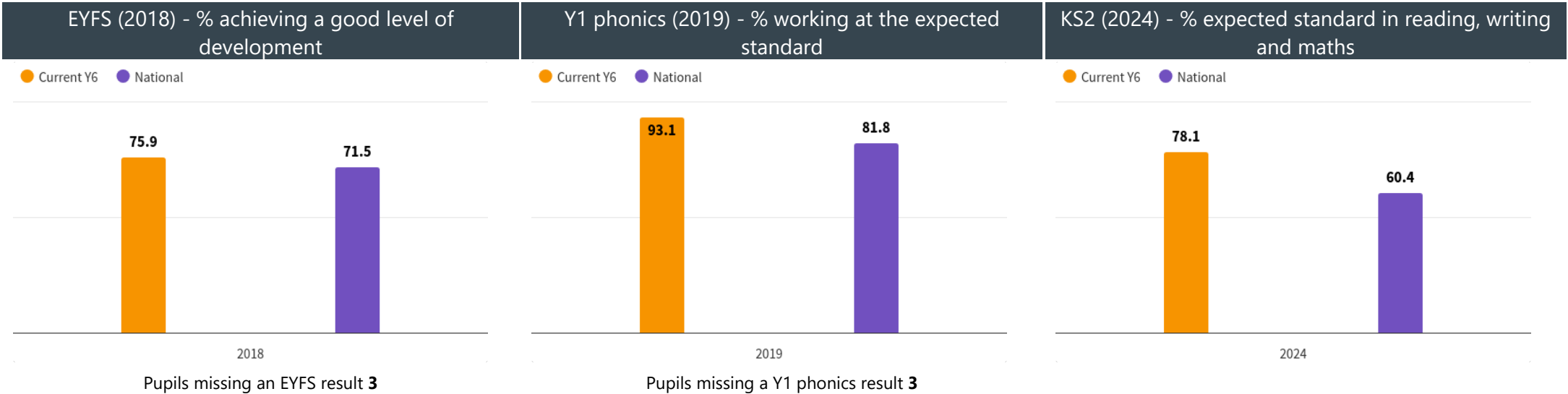

# KS2 attainment report (2024) – Y6 cohort attainment trends

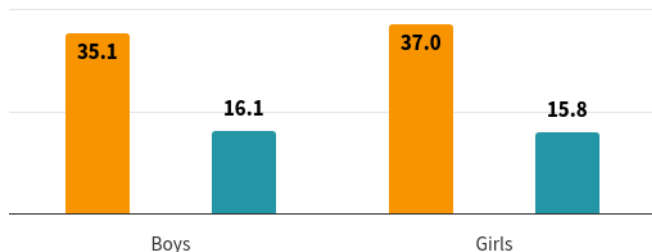

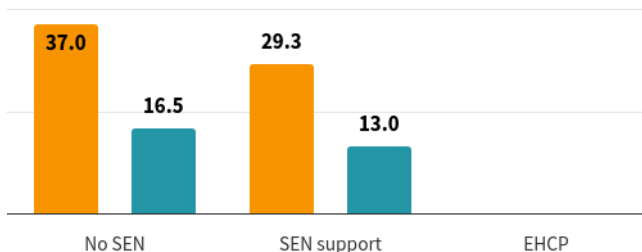
Prior attainment (average score) by gender

Y1 Phonics No. of ELGs



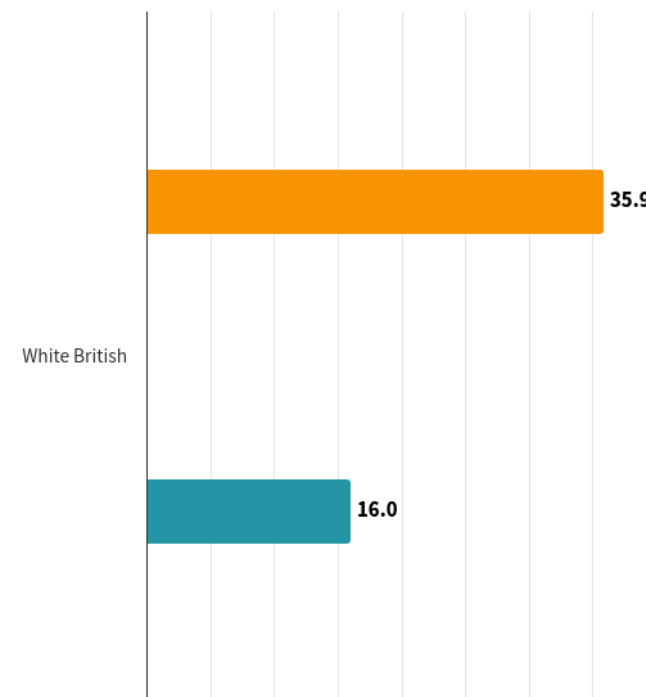
Prior attainment (average score) by SEN

Y1 Phonics No. of ELGs



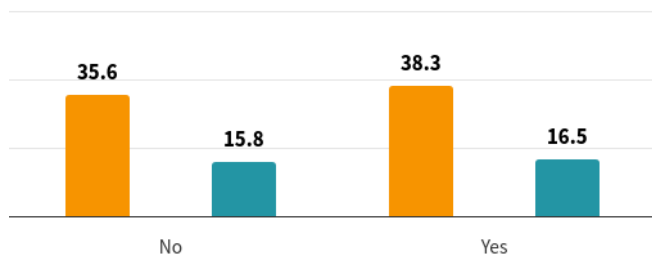
Prior attainment (average score) by ethnicity

No. of ELGs Y1 Phonics



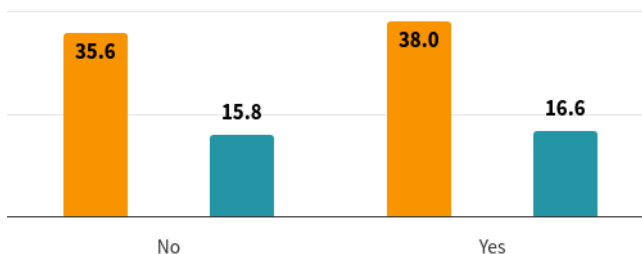
Prior attainment (average score) by FSM eligibility

Y1 Phonics No. of ELGs



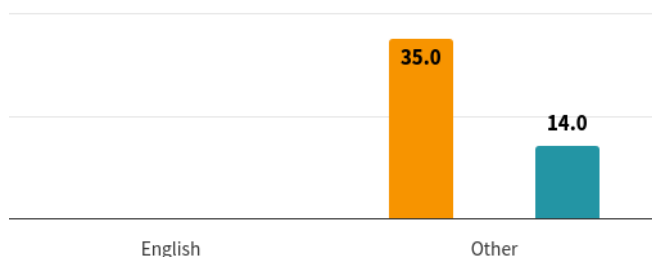
Prior attainment (average score) by disadvantage\*

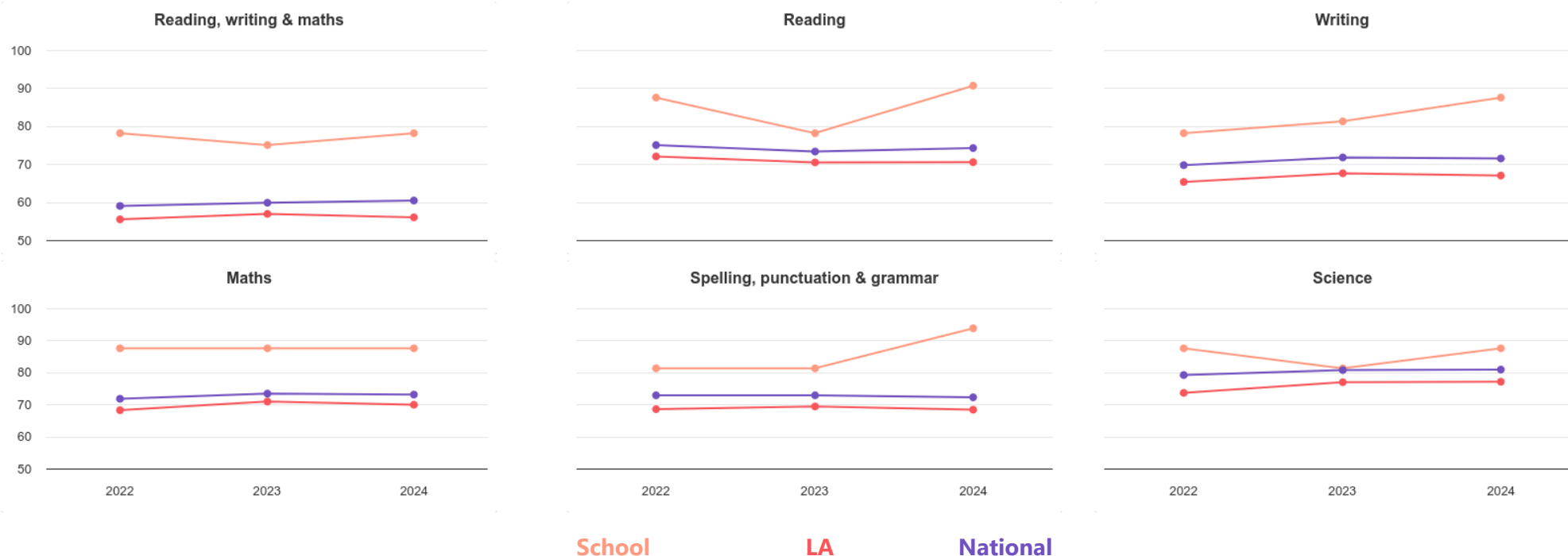

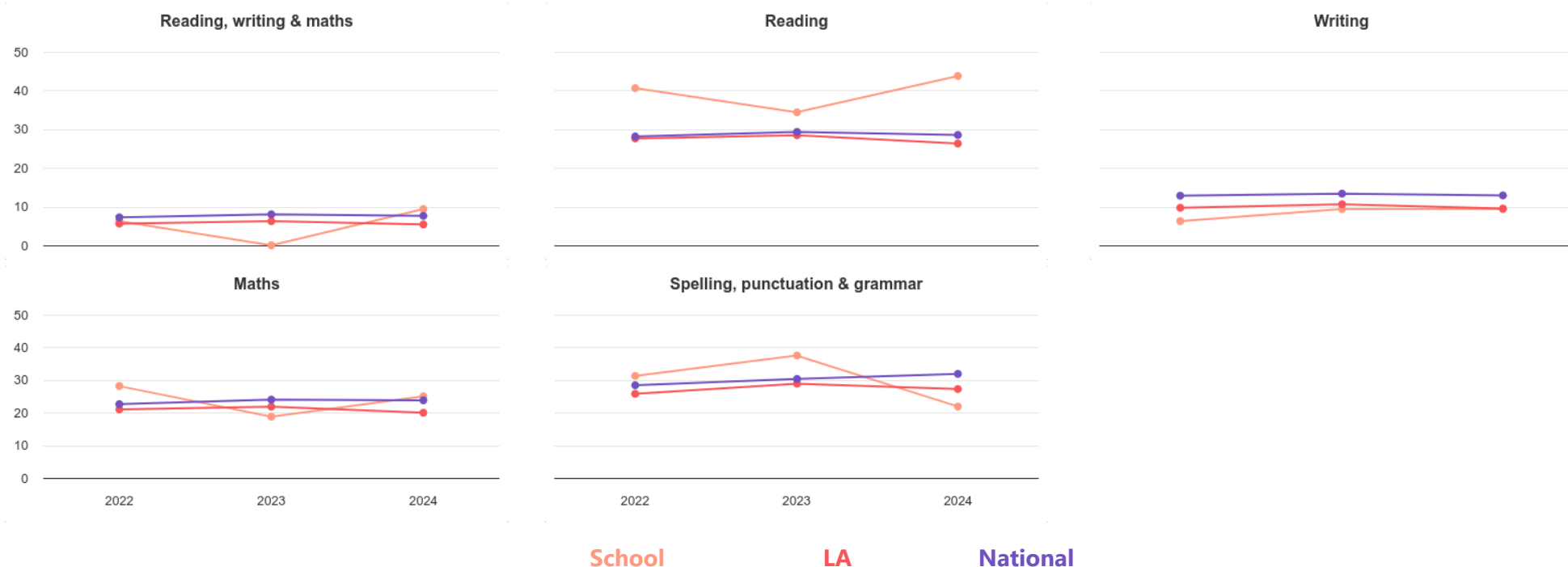

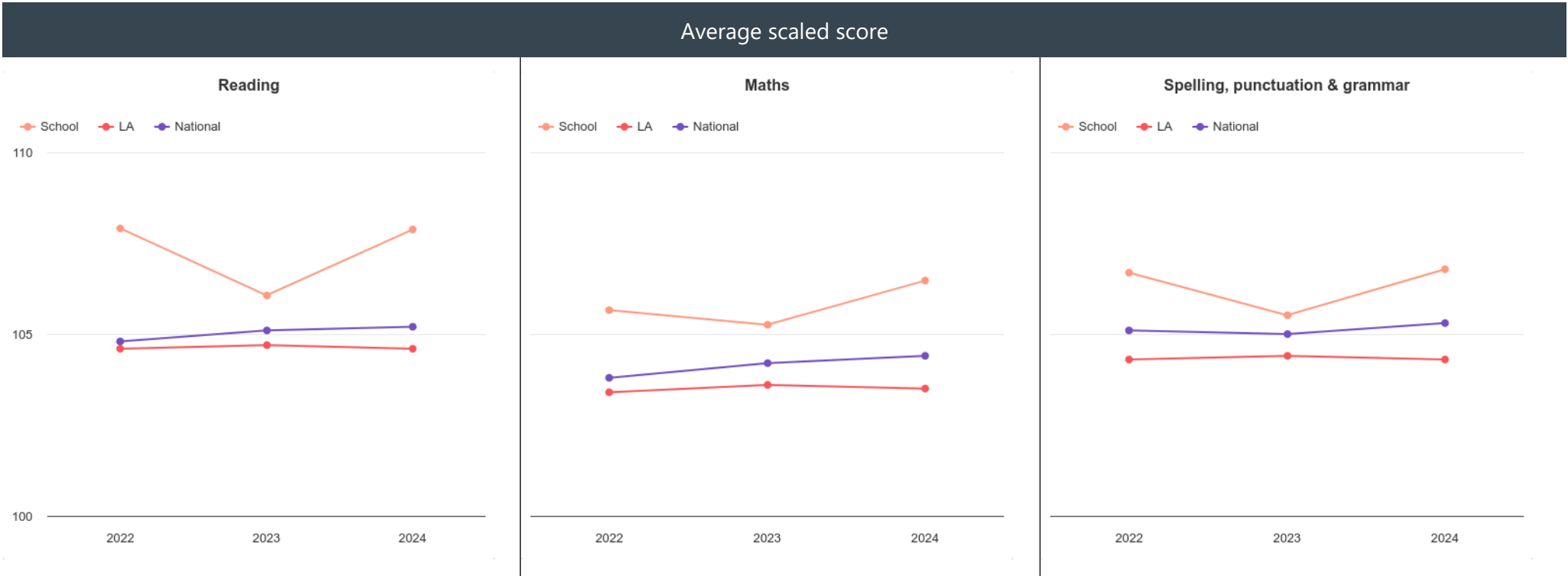

# KS2 attainment report (2024) – Progress from Y1 phonics to KS2 writing

This report shows results in KS2 writing against the pupil's Y1 phonics outcome. Comparisons are shown against national data produced by the DfE in 2023. Note that progress from Y1 phonics is not an official measure of progress and it is not known if the national figures will be updated in 2024. In the absence of KS1 data this report aims to give a sense of how pupils with similar levels of phonics attainment have achieved at the end of KS2.
