



Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s),

The children will explore this term's theme 'to the ends of the earth' through their different class topics.

'Go, therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit' Mt 28:19

In this branch, pupils will learn about the events that flowed from Jesus' resurrection, on Easter Sunday to his ascension in to Heaven and explore what happened when the Holy Spirit visited the disciples at Pentecost. They will learn how our Catholic Church today is an apostolic Church, with liturgies and structures that have been shaped and flow from the important work of Jesus' disciples and the early Church.

TERM 5 THEME: To the Ends of the Earth...

Hear

By the end of this unit of study, pupils will hear the following key texts:

- The empty tomb (Jn 20:1-10)
- The appearance on the shore of Tiberius (Jn 21:1-19)
- The Apostles' Creed

Believe

By the end of this unit of study, pupils will know that the Church teaches that:

- the Pope is the successor to Peter
- the Church is the People of God and is apostolic
- the work of the Church is to continue the ministry of Jesus and build the Kingdom of God
- Mary is the Mother of the Church and Queen of Heaven

Celebrate

By the end of this unit of study, pupils will know:

- that the Apostles' Creed summarises Christian beliefs
- that May is the special month of Mary
- some Marian prayers or hymns, e.g. Hail Mary, the Angelus, the Rosary, the Magnificat, Ave Maria

Live

By the end of this unit of study, pupils will recognise:

- some artistic depictions of the Blessed Virgin Mary as Mother of the Church or as Queen of Heaven from different times and places
- some ways in which the Church today (locally or globally) continues the work of Jesus
