Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s),

The children will explore this term's theme 'Dialogue and encounter' through their different class topics.

"For in him we live and move and have our being" (Acts 17:28)

In this branch, pupils will learn how Christians work together with people of different religious convictions and all people of goodwill towards the common good, respecting the dignity of all humanity. They will also encounter other pathways of belief drawing on the teaching of the Church about intercultural dialogue.

TERM 6 | FS2 THEME: Dialogue and Encounter

Dialogue

Friends of Jesus: Hear a simple life of SS Peter and Paul, friends of Jesus (linking to their feast day). Invite a local parishioner in to talk about their faith and why it matters, to them, to be a friend of Jesus. Explore a range of pictures of Jesus from a non-European tradition.

Encounter

Invite someone in from the local area or a school community member to talk about their local faith community and why it is important to them. Develop opportunities to engage children in a broad sensory curriculum about the music, food, smells, tastes, and specific clothing worn, to enrich understanding.
