Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s),

The children will explore this term's theme 'Dialogue and encounter' through their different class topics.

"For in him we live and move and have our being" (Acts 17:28)

In this branch, pupils will learn how Christians work together with people of different religious convictions and all people of goodwill towards the common good, respecting the dignity of all humanity. They will also encounter other pathways of belief drawing on the teaching of the Church about intercultural dialogue.

TERM 6 Y1 THEME: Dialogue and Encounter

Dialogue

By the end of this unit pupils will know that the Church teaches:

- that it is the community of all those who belong to Christ
- that the cross is a symbol of Christianity
- that the shortest summary of the Catholic faith is the sign of the cross

By the end of this unit of study, pupils will know more about Christianity locally:

- by learning more about their local parish community
- by learning more about their local parish church
- by experiencing music, art and religious objects that reflect different Christian communities other than their local parish.

Encounter

By the end of this unit of study, pupils will have encountered aspects of modern Jewish life in Britain, and used some key vocabulary linked to the Jewish belief in one God. They will learn that the Torah is a sacred text that is a guide for Jewish life that contains stories from the history of the Jewish people.
