
Introduction


This week we are starting our new topic which is all about winter.

If it is cold enough try making an ice decoration.


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Try to find some leaves or small twigs and berries outside and pop them in a container and fill it with water.


If it is cold enough leave them outside all night – or pop them in the freezer. What do you think will happen?


Our Makaton actions this week are cold/winter, snow, ice and wind...
