

Our first week back is our, 'Be Safe - Happy Week'. Every day at school we model, show, and teach our children about all the different ways they can stay safe inside and when they go out and about.



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The children also learn about how to make safe and healthy choices and who to talk to when we feel sad, lonely or worried that we are not safe. This is always done gently and, in age-appropriate ways.

In the first week of Term 2 week the children in FS2 will be learning about the people in our school and local communities who are there to help us. We will reinforce key messages about staying with familiar and trusted grown-ups when they are out and about, and what to do if they ever need any help.

We will explore the best ways of keeping safe when we are out walking and crossing the roads with our grown-ups. Finally, at the end of the week will be learning about Bonfire Night and how to stay safe at fireworks displays.

- Do you know anyone who works in a job that helps other people? Ask them about their job and see if you can have a photograph with them and your mouse.








