

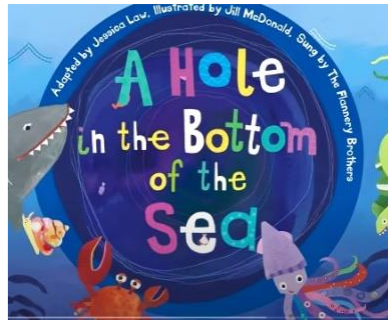
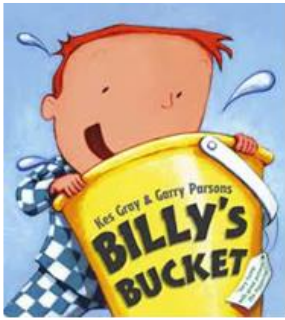

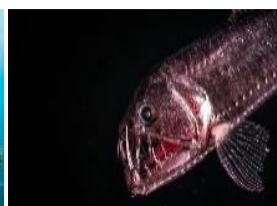
Song of the Week

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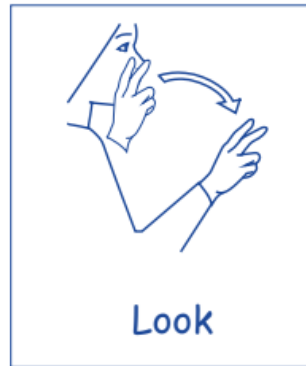
Our Makaton Signs of the Week



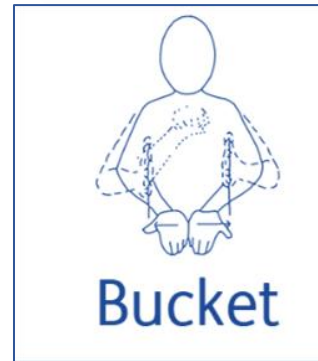
Flat hand brushes down and out from chest.
