


FS2 MOUSE CLUB

- investigating whether all the trees are losing their leaves or not thinking about why
- using your leaves to create your very own leaf pictures, or make leaf rubbings
- counting the leaves you have collected and sorting them by size, colour, etc.
- finding out about some of the animals that live in UK woodlands, with an adult, either in books you have at home, by visiting the library, or online. For example, owls, foxes, badgers, squirrels and hedgehogs (click here)
