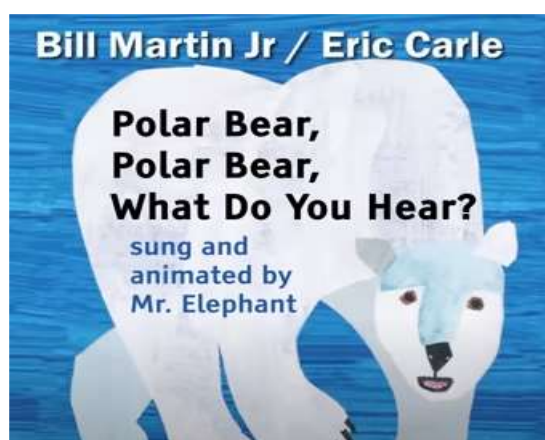
Term 3 – Week 5 (2024-2025)
