

Our song of the week is the 'Boogie Beebies' song called, 'Digging a Hole'. The children can listen to this song by following this <u>link</u>.






Activities to try at Home

Ask your grownups if you can plant vegetable seeds such as lettuce, beans, peas, and radishes. They grow quickly and then you can enjoy eating them!
