Be Safe and Be Happy...

The first week of our new term had a whole-school focus called 'Be Safe, Be Happy'. On your child's Tapestry page, under **Memos**, you'll find links to support some of the activities we've been exploring in class – such as People Who Help Us and Taking Care of Our Teeth.

This week, we will continue learning about the people who help us, as well as talking about ways we can stay safe both at school and at home. We've also been learning that if we ever have a 'worry ball', we must remember to "Tell! Tell!" someone we trust.

The children have also been busy making poppies ready to take to church on **Tuesday 11th November** for our special **Community Service of Remembrance** starting at **10.50am**. This will be their first school service at church, and they will be joined by their Buddies, who will help look after them and show them how to behave respectfully in church.

The children will be learning why the poppy is such an important symbol in the United Kingdom and why we observe Remembrance Day. They will also begin to understand that the people who serve in the UK Armed Forces are among those who help to keep us safe. All of the information and clips shared are age-appropriate and taken from **CBeebies**, making them suitable for our young learners.

Please watch the two clips with your child: **CBeebies: What is Remembrance Day?** They provide a short and child-friendly explanation of Remembrance Day and its significance.


