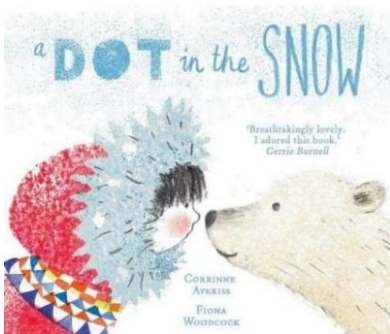




# FS2 MOUSE CLUB

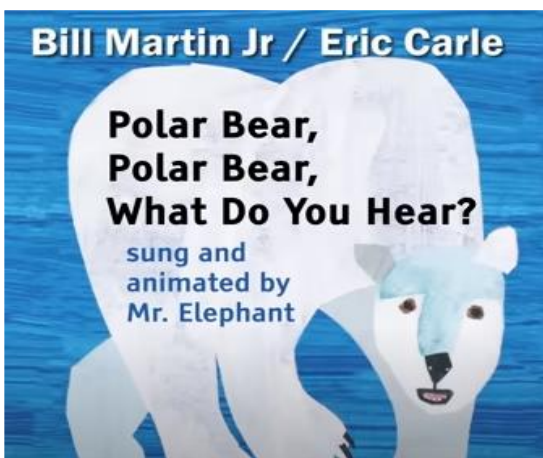
Term 3 – Week 4 (2025-2026)
