POST-PRIMARY VISITS

Once the SEAG test concludes in November, we will collaborate with several local post-primary schools. Our activities will include hosting physical education sessions, attending their school musicals, and conducting an all-day trial of a mini timetable within the school.

Parents and guardians will also meet with Mr Armstrong and the Y7 team to discuss post-primary entrance criteria and receive a brief class progress update.



IT'S YOUR MOVE

Children will participate in a three-week series of workshops led by SU NI, which will concentrate on the Changes, Challenges, and Choices that lie ahead. These workshops are designed to be engaging and interactive, tailored to be suitable for the children's understanding.

We are fortunate to have our amazing school counsellor, Julie Magowan, who leads the 'Take A Beat' workshops focused on emotional awareness and regulation strategies.

Julie also holds weekly drop-in sessions for students who wish to have a chat or share some worries.

IN-CLASS PDMU SESSIONS

Our Y7 team has developed a series of PDMU sessions to be conducted in the weeks leading up to the children's completion.

These sessions focus on:

- **Celebrating the wonderful qualities of each child**
- **Addressing their concerns regarding the transition**
- **Identifying appropriate actions to take in these situations.**
