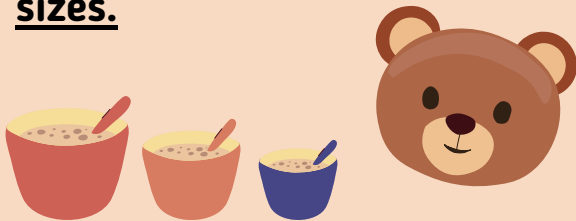

HELPING YOUR CHILD:

- Talk about the size of objects.
- Read stories at bedtime.
- Encourage bringing objects for our blue colour table.
- Encourage the use of safety scissors at home - cutting in straight lines and around objects rather than snipping.
- Play games that require turn-taking.
- Do jigsaw puzzles (12+ pieces)
- Draw pictures together and encourage recognisable images.
- Enjoy our big bedtime reading books and the talking dogs/cats that have started to go home.

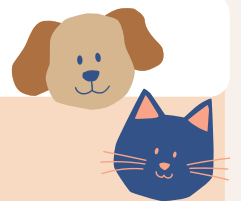
Parent Teacher Consultations
