

Cameron from the Woodstock Library is coming into Nursery read to us on Wednesday 4th March.


An application form will be sent to you to join if you are not a member already. Please return this form to Nursery asap so the library service can process your tickets.

On Friday 6th March after the Nursery day we will go to the library to pick up their cards and borrow their first library books. Parents/guardians must accompany children to the library.


World Book Day
