SEPTEMBER TIPS FOR PARENTS

Dear Parent

We will all be working together to make your child's settling in to Nursery as easy as possible for everyone. If your child is unsettled at nursery my teachers will work with you and explain what to do.

We have a kitchen play corner set up in Nursery to remind us of home. Our water tray has boats, sea creatures, seaweed, nets and fish to remind me of the sea and my holidays. My sand tray has shells, buckets and spades to remind me of days on the beach, and we could talk about my memories of my holidays.

Your child will be learning to share with their friends and how to take turns when playing indoors and outdoors.

We will be learning how to play with paint, junk art and play dough. Help yourself to a play dough recipe in our foyer. It is easy to make.

We will be learning some rhymes and songs which will help your child to settle at snack time and learn the names of their friends. You could help by practising the songs and rhymes at home.

We will have our snack together and of course we will always say 'please' and 'thank you'. Your child is going to love Nursery!

Self registration

Each child has a symbol, it is very important for your child to be able to recognise and find their symbol each day. When you come into Nursery each morning please encourage your child to find their symbol and place it onto the school dinners or packed lunches chart; this will help to give us an indication of how many children will be taking school dinners/packed lunches in October.

Activities and Topics

All of the children are enjoying a range of play opportunities which are familiar to them. At the moment we are building on the children's interest and confidence with familiar and therapeutic activities, such as home corner play, sand and water play, construction and playdough.

As we are returning after a lovely summer holiday we will be talking a lot about Summer experiences e.g. going to the beach, playing with our friends and going on holidays.

The colour we are concentrating on this month is orange and the shape we will be talking about is a circle; please encourage your child to bring in something orange or circle shape (child's name on each object).

COLLECTING YOUR CHILD AT HOME TIME

Home time is a very busy time at the end of the Nursery day. All of the children will be seated at a table when you arrive. Please come into the Nursery room and walk over to collect your child from their table. For safety reasons we do not encourage children to leave their seat until an adult is beside them.
